Hays Tells Labor Representatives Policy for Adjusting Differences

#### VIEWS THEM AS PARTNERS

Washington, March 17. - For the first time in eight years, representatives of the postal employes' unions met vesterday with the postmaster general to discuss questions affecting the personnel of the department, Postmaster General Hays, in announcing a new policy for dealing with the employes, said frequent conferences would be held between department officials and representatives of the employes "for the adjustment of all differences."

Three hundred thousand men and women are engaged in this enterprise," Mr. Hays told the union representa-tives. "We are going to have 300,000 nartners. The postoffice establishment is not an institution for profit and politics; it is an institution for service, and it is the President's purpose that every effort shall be made to improve that service. I know that with 300,-000 men and women pledged to serve all the people and honestly discharge that duty, fairly treated and properly appreciated, all partners with us in the great enterprise, we can do the job."
The postmaster general addressed letters to all postmasters directing their attention to the desirability of partici-pating in the civic activities of their

"By taking an executive interest in the meetings of local chambers of com-merce, boards of trade and other civic and community organizations," Mr. Hays said, "excellent opportunities are afforded for the dissemination of general postal information, essential to the proper conduct of an efficient postal service. 
