

N. J. LEGISLATURE ADJOURNS APRIL 8

Mackay Hopes to Limit Volume of New Laws for Year of 1921

WILL OVERRIDE VETOES

Special Dispatch to Evening Public Ledger. Trenton, March 28.—Republican Senate Leader Mackay wants the 1921 laws to appear like a vast-pocket edition in comparison with the work of recent Legislatures. That is the reason he has had both houses agree to adjourn sine die April 8.

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Constabulary Bill Up

The House tonight or tomorrow will override the governor's veto of the Senate bill for a constabulary. The governor is given authority to name the police superintendent.

Numerous appointments to the higher judiciary, county courts, prosecutors, state departments and county tax boards will be sent to the Senate within a few days, hastened somewhat by the adjournment of the Legislature next week.

Henry J. Snyder, of Jersey City, will be the new state education commissioner to take office July 1, succeeding Dr. Calvin S. Kendall, of Princeton, resigned. It is reported the governor is not ready to name successors to Supreme Court Justices Charles W. Parker, of Jersey City, and James J. Bergen, of Somerville, whose terms expire late this year.

James Baker, of Jersey City, close friend of the governor, will be made president of the state tax board. Mr. Baker is a tax commissioner. He will be given the presidency now held by Frank B. Jess, of Haddon Heights, according to reports. Mr. Jess will be named to the board along with Harry W. Mutchler, of Rockaway, their terms expiring July 1.

Appointments to Be Made

The governor will appoint two commissioners each to the board of commerce and navigation and conservation and development. The terms of J. Spencer Smith, of Tenafly, and Robert E. Engle, of Beach Haven, on the commerce board expire July 1. On the conservation board expire July 1. The governor will nominate four members, two men and two women, to the state board of health. The terms of Clyde Potts, of Morristown, and Thomas Blyde, of Camden, expire July 1.
