

LEGION BACKING DUNN BONUS BILL

Organization Favors Measure
Providing \$10 a Month to
State Veterans

POSTS IN VARIED ACTIVITIES

The activities of Legion interests in Harrisburg is evidenced in the reporting to the House yesterday of the Dunn bonus bill, providing a bonus of ten dollars a month to Pennsylvania war veterans.

The bill provides for the reimbursement of soldiers, sailors and marines who served in the world war for a period of more than sixty days. The limit to be paid to any one person will be \$200, equivalent to twenty months' service. The Legion considers this an equitable arrangement inasmuch as active participation in the war was for a period only slightly in excess of ninety months, though a majority of the men were actually in uniform for a longer period.

Men who obtained exemption for any reason, even though the afterward entered the service, will not be entitled to compensation. 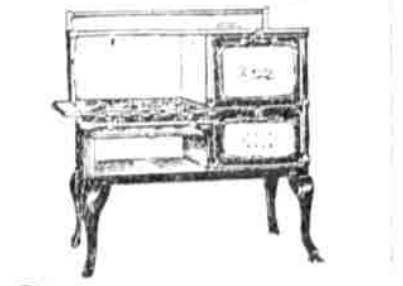

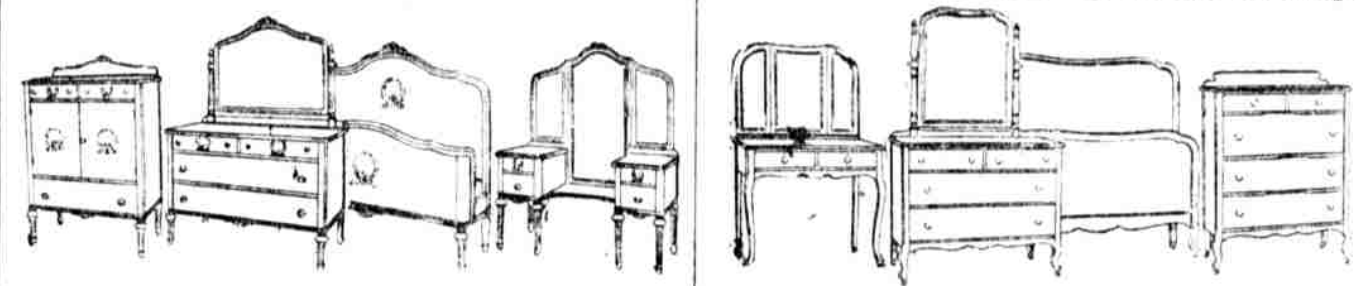

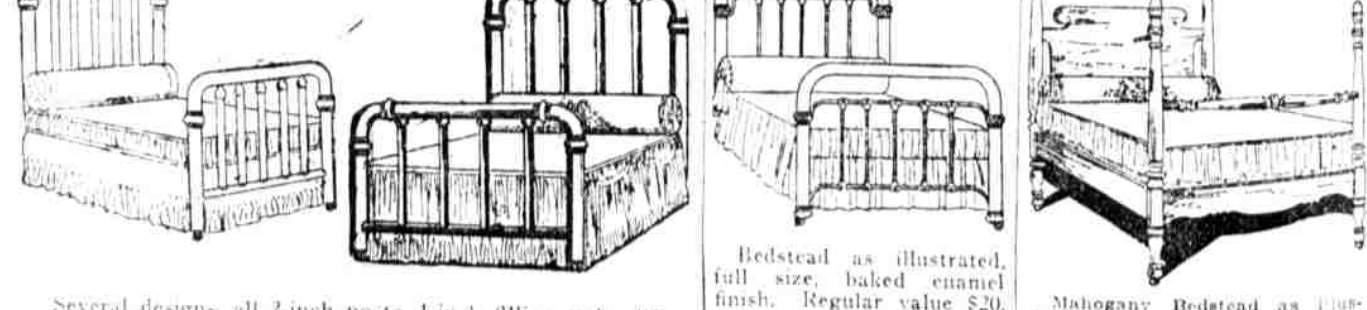
