

### GERMAN BANKROLL BIGGER, ALLIES FIND

Trade Growth Figures Used in Calculation of Ability to Pay Indemnity

### IMMENSE PROFITS CITED

By the Associated Press. Paris, April 12.—Figures compiled by experts to show the extent of Germany's economic revival have been submitted in a report to the reparations commission. This report will be used in the commission's calculation of Germany's capacity to pay.

The bank deposits of Germany have increased last year from 4,500,000,000 marks to 6,250,000,000 marks. The experts declare there has been a marked change in the ratio of imports and exports, which is bringing the value of the total exports to a considerable excess over the value of the imports of Germany. Exports to Holland alone amounted to the equivalent of \$500,000,000 francs last year.

### PLAN BIG HOTEL AT SHORE

\$1,000,000 Apartment Contemplated on Boardwalk at Atlantic City. Atlantic City, April 12.—An ambitious plan to build a \$1,000,000 apartment hotel on the boardwalk at Atlantic City is being pushed by W. J. Stange, an investment banker of Chicago.

Stange purchased the site last month. The property was originally owned by the late Walter R. Edge, who bequeathed it to the state.

### IRISH BESIEGE HOTEL

One of Assaulting Party Is Killed. Several Auxiliaries Wounded. Dublin, April 12.—A battle raged for twenty minutes yesterday around the Northwestern Hotel, in the North Wall section here, when civilians armed with bombs and firearms fiercely attacked the hotel, where government auxiliaries are quartered.

Brazil Buys Coffee to Boost Price. Rio Janeiro, April 12.—(By A. P.)—More than 300,000 sacks of coffee have been purchased in this city and at Santos by the government since March 20, says the Correio de Manha.

The newspaper declares the government is thus carrying out its announced intention to intervene in the market for the purpose of raising the price of Brazil's leading product and improving foreign exchange.
