 Dear Mrs. Wilson—Please let me know how to make banana cake, also tomato sauce, mustard sauce, such as is used on sardines. How are water-cress sandwiches prepared? Can fresh water-cress be obtained all this season?
 MRS. S. S.
 Do you mean layer cake, shortcake or banana loaf cake? Use tomato puree for tomato sauce. Mustard sauce: One and one-half cups of water, two slices of onion, two tablespoons of mustard, one-half teaspoon of thyme, one teaspoon of salt, Bit of celery.
 Summer sardines for fifteen minutes and then strain. Now add: Four tablespoons of butter, Two tablespoons of minced, Two tablespoons of vinegar, Two teaspoons of sugar, One-half cup of cold water, One-half teaspoon of paprika. Dissolve the flour, mustard, sugar, water and vinegar and then add to the boiling liquid. Bring to a boil and cook for five minutes, then simmer slowly until thickness of apple butter. 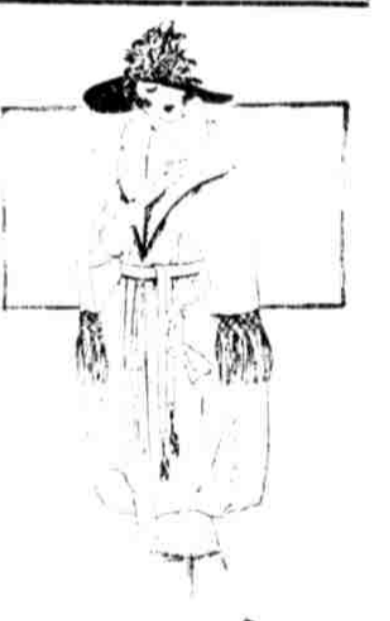
