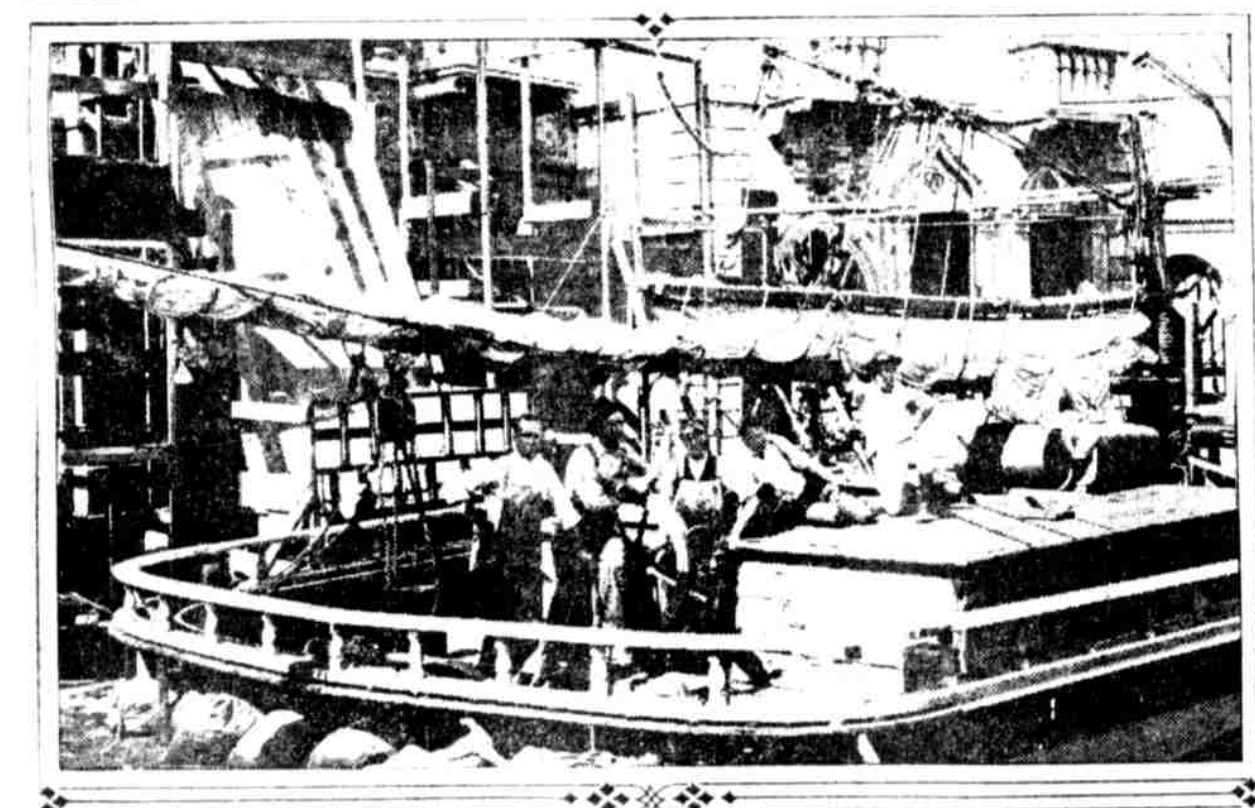
June Mathis has started work on the scenario for Rex Ingram's new feature, a Balzac story, the title of which has not yet been announced.
