

CAPT. HOBEY BAKER TO BE BURIED HERE

Body of Former Princeton Football Star and Air Hero in War Coming From France

TO HAVE MILITARY FUNERAL

The body of Captain Hobey Baker, a Princeton football star and an Air hero in the war, will be buried here tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock in the morning in the presence of a military funeral. The body was brought from France where it was recovered from a crash landing in the Ardennes region last year.

Major Baker was killed in action on May 1, 1918, while flying a single-engine biplane over the front lines near the town of Valenciennes. His plane was shot down and he was captured by the Germans. He was held in a prisoner-of-war camp for several months before being repatriated to the United States.

Baker was a member of the Princeton football team from 1914 to 1916, and was a three-time All-American. He was also a member of the Princeton Air Corps, and was one of the first American pilots to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean.

His funeral will be held at the funeral home of the Philadelphia National City Bank, 15th and Chestnut streets. The body will be buried in the cemetery at 12th and Locust streets.

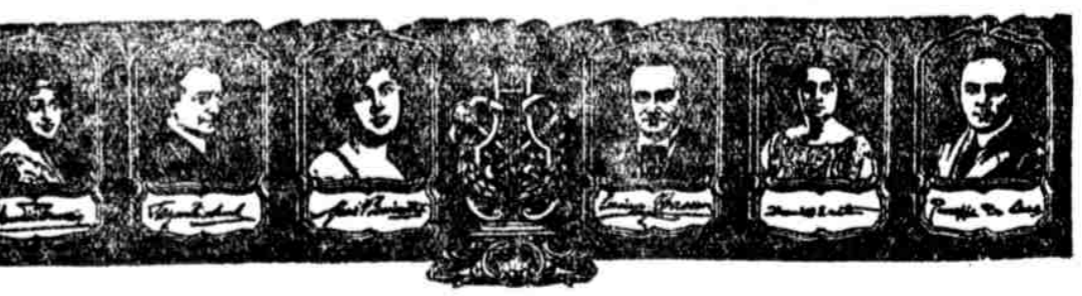
