

CRASH KILLS CHILD; TEN PERSONS HURT

Taxicab Driver Held on Recklessness Charge After Fatal Collision in Park

TWO YOUNG WOMEN INJURED

A child was killed and ten other persons were injured, more or less seriously, in an automobile accident over the weekend. In the accident in which the fatal tragedy occurred the driver of the taxicab, who was driving an automobile on the East River drive between Washington Hall and Ridge streets.

The child killed was Mildred Kester, eleven years old, of 321 Callowhill street, and those injured were John A. Johnson, of 2243 North Front street, driver of the taxicab; William Holmes, of 2211 Callowhill street, grandfather of the child; Mrs. Sarah Holmes, wife of William Holmes; Mrs. Helina Wasson, of 3041 a grand street; and William Moore, nine years old grandson of Mrs. Wasson.

Mrs. Wasson and her grandson are critically hurt, but the others are only slightly hurt. All were taken to the Memorial Hospital.

Eleven-year-old girl who was killed when a taxicab, in which she was riding, struck a touring car, she lived at 321 Callowhill street.

Johnson tried to swerve his machine, he was told.

James E. King and Maud Tyson, of 2243 North Front street, were slightly injured when they were struck by the taxicab. Both young women were taken to the Presbyterian Hospital, while the driver was taken to the Sixty-first and Thompson street station to await a hearing.

Soldier Is Injured

While on his way to a military funeral yesterday, Private Carl Kopp, a member of the Sixteenth Ordnance Company of the Franklin Arsenal, was injured when the motorcar in which he and other soldiers were riding swerved to avoid striking another machine on Oxford street and ran into the Pennsylvania Railroad bridge. A heavy log was broken and he was taken to the Franklin Hospital. The others riding in the truck were uninjured.

While walking at Broad street and Broad Street avenue yesterday, Alvin Stephany, of 1445 Westmoreland street, was struck and slightly injured by an automobile. The machine was

owned and operated by John Blake, of 250 West Rockland street. Stephany was treated at the Samaritan Hospital for cuts and bruises.

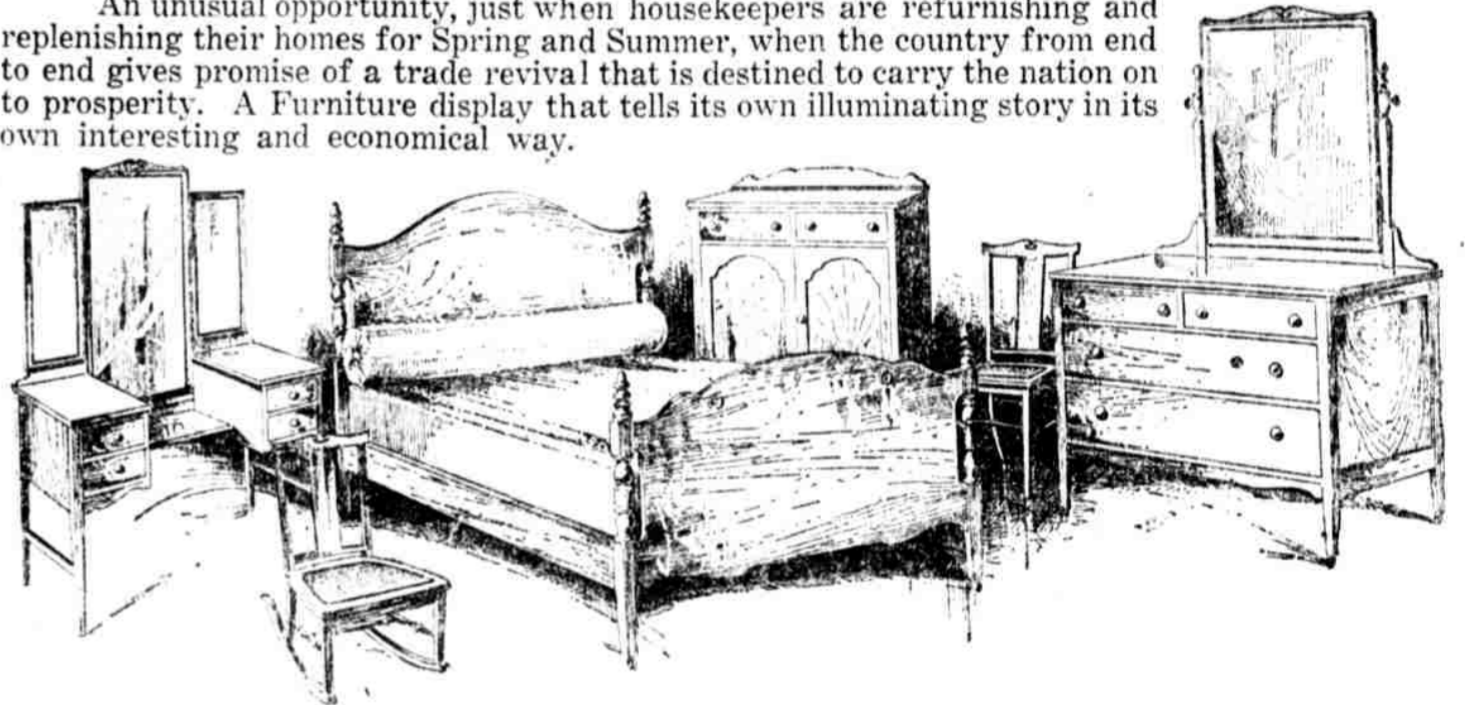

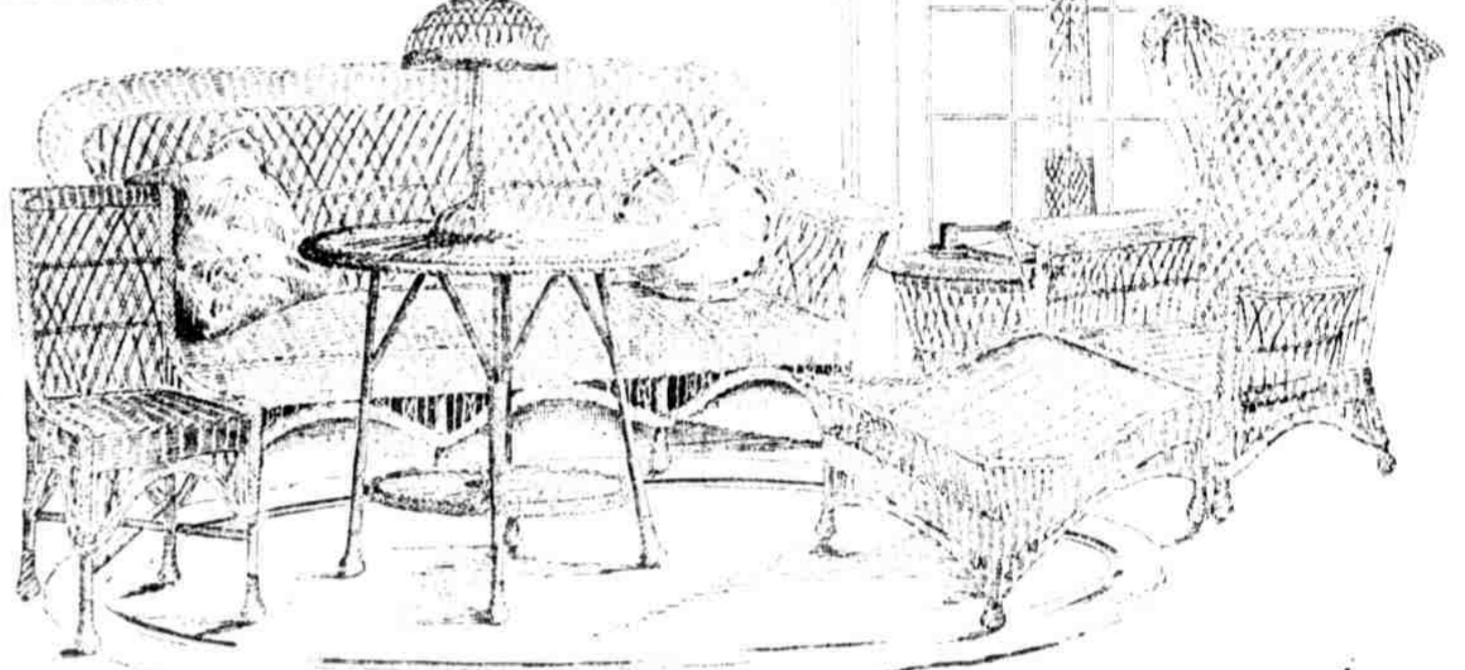
