Old York Road Centre Seeking \$4000 to Continue Work

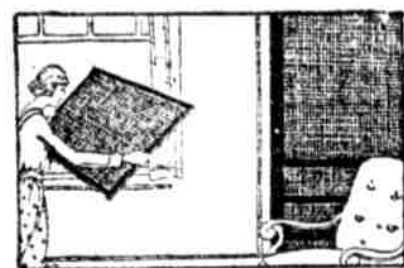

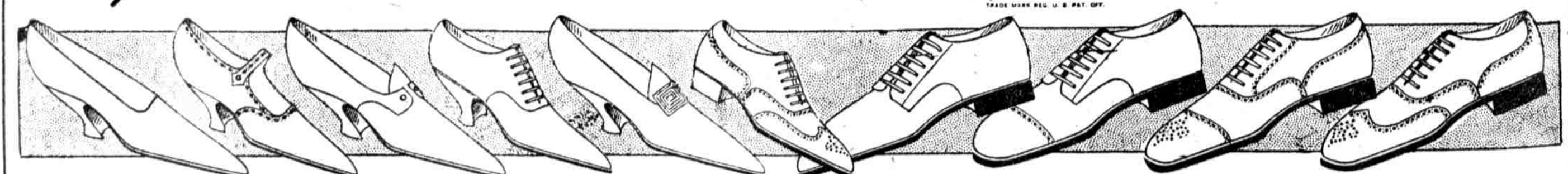
