BOY SCOUTS FIGHT FIRE

Penn State Students Also Take Hand in Putting Out a Blaze Pennsburg, Pa., May 10.—Working the greater part of the night, members of Pennsburg troop of Boy Scouts unassisted extinguished a forest fire which had assumed a two-mile sweep on Mill Hill, near East Greenville. The origin of the fire has not been determined.

State College, Pa., May 10.—More than 100 Penn State students went out to fight the largest forest fire of the year on Tussey Mountain last night.

The fire started on the far side of Mill Hill from Houshburg. The college forestry department fire truck furnished transportation. Many were summoned to fight fire all night.

BRITISH TRANSPORT MEN TO ACT TODAY

Take Up Question of Handling Imported Coal During Miners' Strike

TALK OF GENERAL WALKOUT

Special Cable Dispatch, Copyright, 1921 London, May 10.—Today is a momentous day for England's labor situation, as officials of the transport workers' federation are meeting to consider the matter of handling imported coal.

The Glasgow dock workers have sent a resolution to the federation to call a general strike. Robert Williams, secretary of the transport workers, and one of the officials of the "Triple Alliance," is reported to be actively favoring a general walkout.

The government is plainly alarmed at the trend of events, but it has determined, no matter what means may be necessary, that the coal required for vital industries shall be unloaded and distributed.

The only hopeful note expressed in the House of Commons on the situation was when Premier Lloyd George said no possible means for bringing about a coal settlement are being neglected. He added that it was undesirable for him to say more.

The coal strike, which is on its fortieth day, has resulted in 200,000 persons being thrown out of work at London. In the House of Commons yesterday afternoon it was stated that 1,824,000 are on the unemployed list throughout the country, as a whole, and 1,070,000 are working part time.

"MOVIE" PATRON ROBBED

Bandits Then Shoot Victim in Lobby of Bowery Theatre New York, May 10.—Two robbers staged a holdup within the doors of a crowded Bowery motion picture theatre last night, afterward shooting the victim, a clerk, who was robbed while in the theatre lobby. The clerk was seated

in the center of the house when a well-dressed man told him his brother was ill in the washroom. When the clerk entered the room a second man with a revolver halted him and took \$500 in cash. As the clerk followed the pair into the lobby, pleading for the return of the money, the robbers shot him twice and escaped in the crowd.

The audience, hearing the shots, fled from the house through a back door. Foley Quits Shipping Board Washington, May 10.—The resignation of Captain Paul Foley, U. S. N., as director of operations of the shipping board, was announced last night by Chairman Benson, W. B. Keene, assistant director of operations, has been designated acting director. Captain Foley, who was formerly tank steamship executive of the board, was appointed director of operations in March, 1920, succeeding John E. Cushing, of San Francisco.

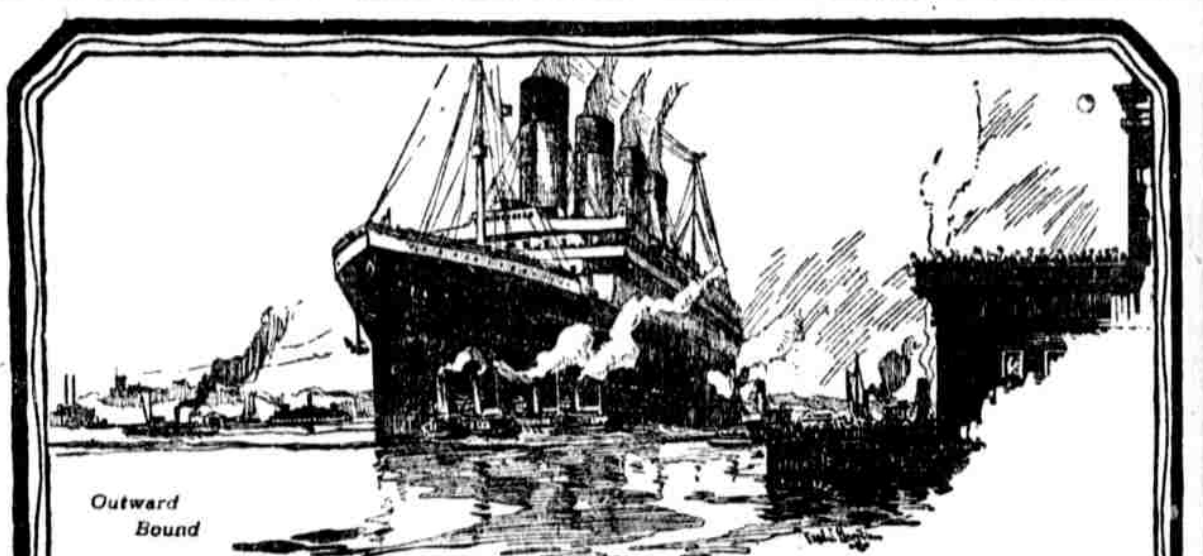
