

# 11 SUICIDES START N.Y. BOHEMIA PROBE

## Mayor Hylan Told of Lures to Destruction in Greenwich Village

### YOUNG GIRLS END LIVES

New York, June 3.—Eleven suicides in an area of five square blocks, all in the Bohemia, ending in disillusionment, accompanied by self-inflicted pistol wounds or the draining of a bottle labeled "poison." All within one year. The music constantly assailing the ears. Nights made hideous by raucous shouting of revelers on their way home, ward from iniquitous rendezvous, where morose children "subjected to the evils of both sexes at all hours of the day and night in Washington Square Park." Girls, sixteen and seventeen, attracted by the supposedly realistic life, finally awakening to realities after it is too late and finding that "suicide was the only dignified way out of it."

### Mock at Churches

Drunkenness, cigarette smoking and worse characterizing the conduct of women who, in passing houses of worship, level on the steps of the churches and sacrilegiously mock the Divinity and glorify in their adherence to atheism and profanity.

All this and more that is worse is declared Mrs. Louis Sherwin, of 18 West Eighth street, an old-time resident of the Village. "In Minette lane, it is a Mecca for dope fiends and the worst element in the life of the village," she alleged.

### Atmosphere Capitalized

It was Mrs. Sherwin who told of the suicides—two of them school teachers, three writers and the rest struggling artists. The Rev. Father Joseph Breslin, rector of St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church, Washington place and Sixth avenue, corroborated much that Mrs. Sherwin bore witness to. He deplored the inebriety and cigarette smoking of the "girls of seventeen and eighteen," and described them on

their knees in pretense of worship outside the church and hysterically shrieking words of derision and scorn as they crossed themselves.

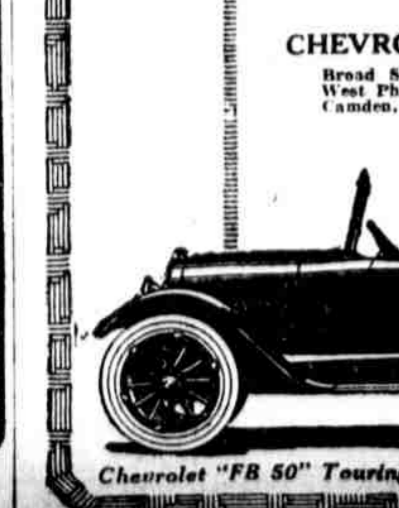
