

**DAYLIGHT SAVING  
BEGINS ON SUNDAY**

Clocks Here and in Suburbs  
Will Be Moved Ahead One  
Hour at 2 A. M.

**RAILROADS MOST AFFECTED**

A daylight-saving plan for Philadelphia will be put into effect on Sunday morning at 2 o'clock. At that hour all clocks in this city will be moved forward one hour.

The same plan will be adopted in suburban towns and at places where commuters to Philadelphia live and will continue until the last Sunday in September.

In view of the fact that the daylight plan offers more opportunity for outdoor sports, as well as being beneficial to industrial interests, it has met with general popularity.

**Railroads Most Affected**

The railroads are more affected by the change in time than any others in the city. All railroad schedules are being readjusted to the new arrangement.

The Philadelphia and Reading Railway, the Pennsylvania Railroad and the Baltimore and Ohio have had thousands of timetables and pocket cards printed giving the changes.

The effects are these:  
First. All local trains used by commuters will be moved forward one hour. For instance, the Doylestown Express, which now leaves Reading Terminal at 5:02 P. M. Eastern standard time, will leave at 4:02 P. M. Eastern standard time, which will be 5:02 P. M. daylight-saving time.

Second. All through trains will remain on their present Eastern standard time schedules. For instance, the Pittsburgh Express, leaving Broad Street Station now at 11:10 P. M. Eastern standard time, will continue to leave at that hour, which will be 12:10 A. M. daylight-saving time.

Third. All milk and through mail trains will remain on their present schedules.

All timetables printed for the railroads carry Eastern standard time, and one hour must be added to the time given to make it daylight-saving time.

All trains to seashore points will be run one hour earlier than their present schedules in order to make them conform with the daylight-saving plan.

Postmaster Thornton has issued an order that none of the postoffice clocks shall be affected by the change in Philadelphia's time.

**More Working Hours Ahead**

But in order to adjust the delivery and collection of mails to the new system working hours will be moved forward one hour.

That means that those carriers and others who now report at 7:20 A. M. Eastern standard time, will report 6:20 A. M., according to the postoffice clocks, which will be 7:20 A. M., according to daylight-saving clocks in the city.

That will make the deliveries at the same business hours as they are today, according to the business men's clocks.

The only mail matter that will be affected will be that arriving in the city in the early morning hours and now making the first delivery in the

morning will be delayed one hour. For instance, the mail arriving on the 4:45 A. M. train from the South will not make the first delivery, because it will be 5:45 A. M., city time, when it arrives and there will not be sufficient time to sort it and make it ready for the first delivery.
