

CHICAGO MAYOR'S FORCES DEFEATED

Thompson Beaten for First Time in His Political Career at Judicial Election

LOSES OWN WARD BY 4000

Chicago, June 7.—Mayor Thompson yesterday received the first defeat in his political career, and it was of such proportions that predictions are freely made that it means the initial step in overthrowing him completely. The occasion was the election of Superior and Circuit Judges, and the coalition ticket, made up of Republicans opposed to the Thompson organization, was elected in its entirety by large pluralities.

Both sides had put forth their utmost strength. Every newspaper in the city was fighting the Thompson ticket and the public was thoroughly aroused. The coalition ticket carried thirty wards, and the City Hall won five. The total vote was near a half million, a record for a judicial election. Mayor Thompson lost his own ward by 4000.

The proposition to furnish free textbooks for public school children carried, and that means the School Board must expend \$1,000,000 between now and September, \$600,000 next year and a like sum the following year. The proposition to issue \$3,000,000 in bonds to build a new jail was overwhelmingly defeated.

Rioting was marked by the killing of a coalition watcher at the polls by a policeman, several small riots and many charges of fraud. According to the police, the slain man had used profanity in the presence of women voters, and it was declared that he was shot when he resisted arrest.

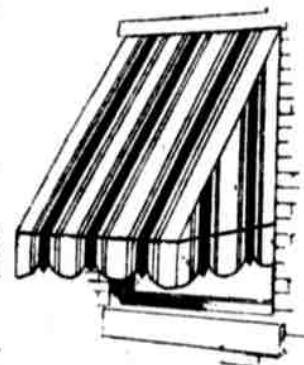
