FINAL JUDGMENT WITHHELD

Oberlin, O., June 22.—President Harding must choose "between the league in his Cabinet, which he made, or the bitter-enders in the Senate, who made him," declared Hamilton Holt, New York magazine editor, who led the pro-league Republicans, in the commencement address at Oberlin College here today.

Mr. Holt asserted that a "clear majority of the American people want the United States to enter some kind of an association of nations with enough teeth in it to actually lessen the probabilities of war."

The inauguration ceremony itself was part of the 220th commencement exercises.

Of the 769 degrees conferred in course, 239 were of Bachelor of Arts in the college; 208 of Bachelor of Science, and the others in the graduate departments.

Among the honorary degrees conferred were:

Master of Arts—William Rose Bonet, Yale 1907, poet at the recent commemorative exercises for Yale men who lost their lives in the war, associate editor of the Literary Review and the New York Evening Post; Miss Julia Lathrop, chief of the Children's Bureau of the United States Department of Labor.

Doctor of divinity—William James Hutchins, president of Berea College.

Doctor of letters—George Bird Grinnell, author; Archibald Marshall, English novelist.

Doctor of Science—Hideo Noguchi, of Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research; Madame Curie, discoverer of radium.

Doctor of laws—John William Davis, recently United States Ambassador to Great Britain; Dr. Angell.

Professor William Lyon Phelps, in presenting Madame Curie, said: "It is superfluous to mention her discoveries in science, and now she has discovered America. She has often encountered dangers in scientific experiments, but nothing so dangerous as American hospitality; it is to be hoped she will not be a woman killed by kindness. She is unique. There is only one thing rarer than genius, and that is radium. She illustrates the combination of both."
