ORDERS OWN DEATH BY FIRING SQUAD

"Fire!" Commands French Lieutenant, Who Abandoned Position in Verdun Battle

WAR DRAMA IS REVEALED

By the Associated Press Paris, June 30.—The demand of Deputy Andre Berthon that he be permitted to interpellate the Cabinet on measures to be taken against General Boyer for having two second lieutenants, Herdun and Millet, summarily shot during the battle of Verdun, has brought out one of the most dramatic incidents of the war.

The circumstances have revealed that the lieutenants, who were commanding sections during a critical period of the battle for Fleury, brought back their men without orders and were found forty-eight hours later in the citadel of Verdun with some of their men. An investigation showed, according to the Echo de Paris, that the section commanders and these men retired in such a way as to uncover and endanger the whole line. General Boyer thereupon ordered the lieutenants shot without further procedure.

mitted to give the command to fire to the squad which executed him, declared: "Soldiers: You are going to shoot me, but I am not a coward and neither is my comrade. We, however, abandoned a position in which we should have remained to the bitter end. If you ever find yourselves in the same situation hold out until the death. Don't abandon your posts. Now aim straight for the heart. Take aim! Fire!"

All the facts, with Lieutenant Herdun's talk to the soldiers, were reported by General Boyer to his superiors, who approved the death order.
