## **GRAND JURY BACKS** MEMORIAL MOVE

June Panel Approves Petition Proposing Building Honoring Fighters in Late War

\$1,250,000 AVAILABLE

Erection of Philadelphia's war me-norial received its first impetus yester-lay by approval from the June Grand of a petition asking official sanc-

tion of the work.

With that idea in view, the work could qualify for the appro-priation of \$1.000,000 made by Coun-ells in 1915 for a convention hall and for the \$250,000 appropriation now in possession of the Park Commission to have d in the building of a soldiera used in the building of a soldiers'

The petition for a memorial hall, originated by the Americah Legion, is based on an act of the Legislature passed last March which authorizes the erection of memorial buildings in bonor of war veterans. The law provides that when a petition signed by fifty citizens has been presented to the County Commissioners, it shall be laid before two successive Grand Juries for their approval. The matter will then herore approval. The matter will then their approval the voters at a general election by the Commissioners.

The first approval was obtained from the retiring Grand Jury yesterday.

County Commissioners Holmes and Kuenzel appeared before a jury to support the proposed building. Approval by the next jury will give the Commissioners the right to go ahead and by the next jury will give the Com-missioners the right to go ahead and submit the matter to the citizens. The act specifies that the Commissioners may acquire a desirable site by pur-chase, donation or condemnation under the right of eminent domain.

It is also provided that donations and butions may be accepted for the rpose by the Commissioners from inlividuals, associations and organizadividuals, associations and organiza-tions.
