

# LEGION WILL SEND 250 MEN TO FRANCE

**Delegation Will Take Part in  
Dedications of War  
Memorials**

John G. Emery, a commander of the American Legion, has decided to accept an invitation from the French Government to represent an official party representing the legion to France. The invitation was extended informally some time ago, and Mr. Emery has been assured it will be forwarded through official channels at an early date.

The delegation will consist of 250, and will be made up by allocating 200 places to State departments on the basis of their paid-up membership. The remaining fifty will be placed at the disposal of the national commander, to care for past national officials and newspapermen.

The guests of the French Government will leave New York in August, as at present, and the trip will occupy between six and seven weeks.

The official itinerary in France will take sixteen days, and it is planned to allow a further week for individual excursions.

Among other ceremonies, the legions will unveil a statue of Joan of Arc at Blois, the gift to the city of the Joan of Arc Committee of New York. They will dedicate a bronze tablet on Marshal Foch's birthplace at Panz, visit Toulon, Lyon, Metz and Strasbourg, have a meeting with and dedice a reception by the city, and will unveil a monument at Flirey presented by Lorraine and the municipality of Thiaucourt. To the American Army Visits to Thiaucourt, Verdun and the St. Mihiel sectors of the battle line will be made.
