

## MME. MATZENAUER WEDS

**METROPOLITAN STAR MARRIED TO FLOYD GLOTZBACH AT CARLSBAD**  
New York, July 13.—Word has been received here of the marriage in Carlsbad on June 18 of Margarita Matzenauer, principal contralto of the Metropolitan Opera Co., and Floyd Glotzbach, of New York. None of the attending guests at the opera house could say definitely as to the identity of Mr. Glotzbach.

This wedding marks the singer's second matrimonial venture, she having been married in 1912 to Eduardo Ferari-Fontana, of Buenos Aires. She obtained a divorce from him in White Plains, seven years later.

Mme. Matzenauer went abroad following the last operatic season here with the honor of having created the greatest sensation of her career while singing last season at the Metropolitan. There she sang for the first time since the war the role of Isolde.
