MOTHER-DESERTER DECLARED INSANE

Mrs. Musick, Who Abandoned Children, Is 'Feeble-Minded,' Women's Lunacy Body Rules

IS ORDERED TO HOSPITAL

Mrs. Mollie Musick, the woman who was convicted by a jury of having abandoned her two children, was de-

clared to be of feeble mind today by a special lunacy commission composed of women.

The case was unusual because this was the first time in the history of the courts that a lunacy commission composed of women has been appointed.

On the commission were Miss Tillie S. Thompson, a young woman member of the bar; Dr. Mand A. Boyer, a physician connected with the Municipal Court, and Adeline H. Turner, a woman probation officer.

The commission was appointed recently to inquire into the mental condition of Mrs. Musick, after the jury which convicted her had recommended mercy. Physicians who examined the woman said they believed her mind was not sound.

LAUNCH BATTLESHIP IN FALL

Washington Will Leave Ways at Camden in September

The Washington, the third American battleship with electric drive installation, will be launched at Camden, N. J., early in September, the Navy Department announced today. It is the fourth ship in the navy to bear the name, the first three being sailing vessels, built in 1814, 1816 and 1843. The new Washington is a sister ship of the Maryland, which it is expected will be turned over to the navy early in August, and the Colorado and West Virginia, now in course of construction, all mounting sixteen-inch guns.

Miss Jean Summers, daughter of Congressman J. W. Summers, of Walla Walla, Wash., will be sponsor when the new craft is launched.
The Washington, which is being built by the New York Shipbuilding Corporation, has a displacement of 32,000 tons, is 624 feet long and 97 feet in beam.
