

LOUVAIN LIBRARY CORNERSTONE LAID

Work on America's Gift to Belgium Starts With Elaborate Ceremony

HARDING SENDS MESSAGE

By the Associated Press Louvain, Belgium, July 28.—The cornerstone of the new library of the University of Louvain, planned as a gift of the American people to the people of Belgium, was laid with elaborate ceremony here today.

The building to be erected will replace the world-famous library of Louvain, destroyed by the German army in its invasion of Belgium in 1914. The representatives of leading American and other universities participated in the ceremonies.

American will watch this splendid building rise like the phoenix from its ashes to bear witness to the unbreakable bonds that bind America to Belgium, to France, to Great Britain and to all their Allies.
