U. S. QUERIES DOUGLAS

Envoys Must Forward Text of Speech Made at Peru's Fete

Santiago, Chile, Aug. 3.—(By A. P.)—Albert Douglas, head of the United States special delegation to the Peruvian centennial celebration, has been asked by the State Department in Washington to forward to that city the text of an address he made in Lima on July 28. Dispatches quoted Mr. Douglas, which have been received here, have aroused considerable feeling on the part of Chileans. The following official statement was published here today:

"The Department of State has spontaneously informed our Ambassador in Washington, that upon learning of declarations attributed in press dispatches to Special Ambassador Douglas it has asked for the text of his address the details of which are as yet unknown.

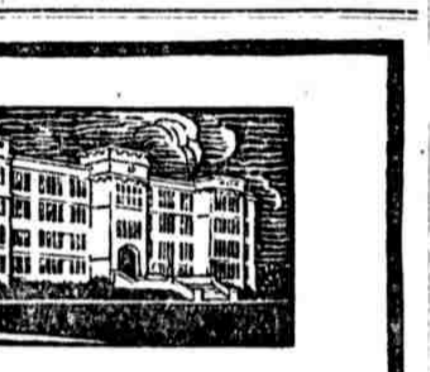
