

BLOOD PRESSURE SCOUTED AS SURE PROOF OF GUILT

Dr. John Egan, Police Surgeon, Doubts Plan Is Practicable in Present Stage of Experiments

The shooting up of a prisoner's blood pressure while he is being cross-examined might be an indication of his guilt, but there is no definite way to find out if this is true.

Dr. Egan drew a more homely instance of the difficulty in judging a man's guilt by his excitability. "Suppose," he said, "a policeman should go up to a perfectly sane man on the street and say, 'I have a warrant out for your arrest. If the man is calm and self-possessed he is apt to say, 'On what charge, officer?'"

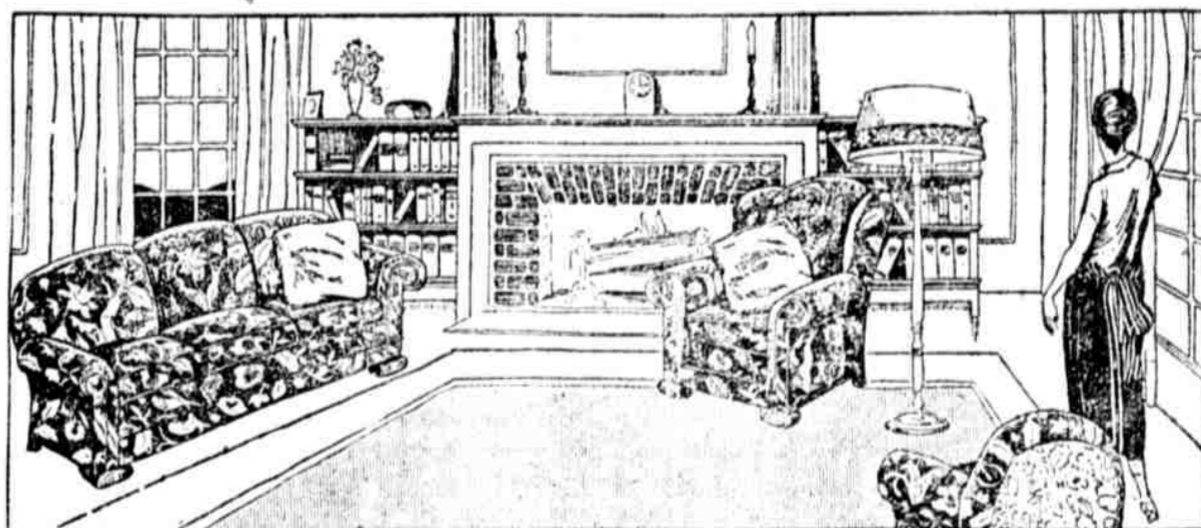

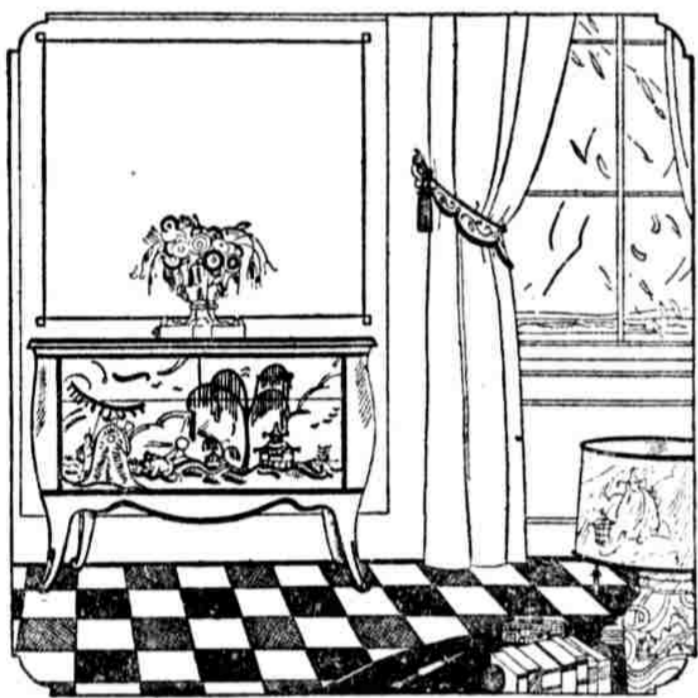
