

SEWAGE PIPE ENDS AUDUBON BATHING

Town Blames Haddon Heights for Letting Waste Pollute Waters of Lake

CALLED TYPHOID CAUSE

Residents of Audubon, N. J., are having more trouble keeping clean, or cool, or whatever it is that people go in bathing in the summer for. Now their beloved Haddon Lake is guarded by gruff policemen, the bathhouses and refreshment stand are deserted and where the one-piece bathing suits were wont to cavort in the limpid there floats languidly the deserted rowboat once manned by bearded life-guards. And it all started yesterday.

Audubon town fathers have discovered that the sewage from Haddon Heights has been emptying into the lake and blame this for the outbreak of typhoid fever which has been worrying the health authorities.

War is on between the two boroughs. In the meantime Audubon residents are keeping clean—or cool—in their bathhouses.

Haddon Lake has been the source of much excitement all summer. First off a hot controversy started over one-piece bathing suits. Then the reformers fought the erection of a refreshment stand and the bathhouses. The bathing suit scrap ended in a draw—with the opponents of the skirt having the shade. The refreshment booth and the bathhouses won by a clean knockout, being built a month ago.

It has been a custom of most of the

residents to go in bathing frequently. On hot days the lake was crowded. Despite the frequent bathing, Haddon Heights officials say—because of the frequent bathing, Audubon town officials say—the town has recently had a number of cases of typhoid fever.

Along about last Thursday the Audubon town fathers learned that the sewage from Haddon Heights was being discharged into the lake near the borough boundary line. It has discharged

there since Haddon Heights had a sewage system. A hot controversy followed the discovery of the discharge pipe. Haddon Heights insists that the sewage is disinfected before going into the lake, but Audubon said, "No," and laid the numerous cases of typhoid to the Haddon Heights sewage system. A sample of the water was sent to Trenton to be analyzed and the report caused the lake to be "closed down" yesterday until further notice.

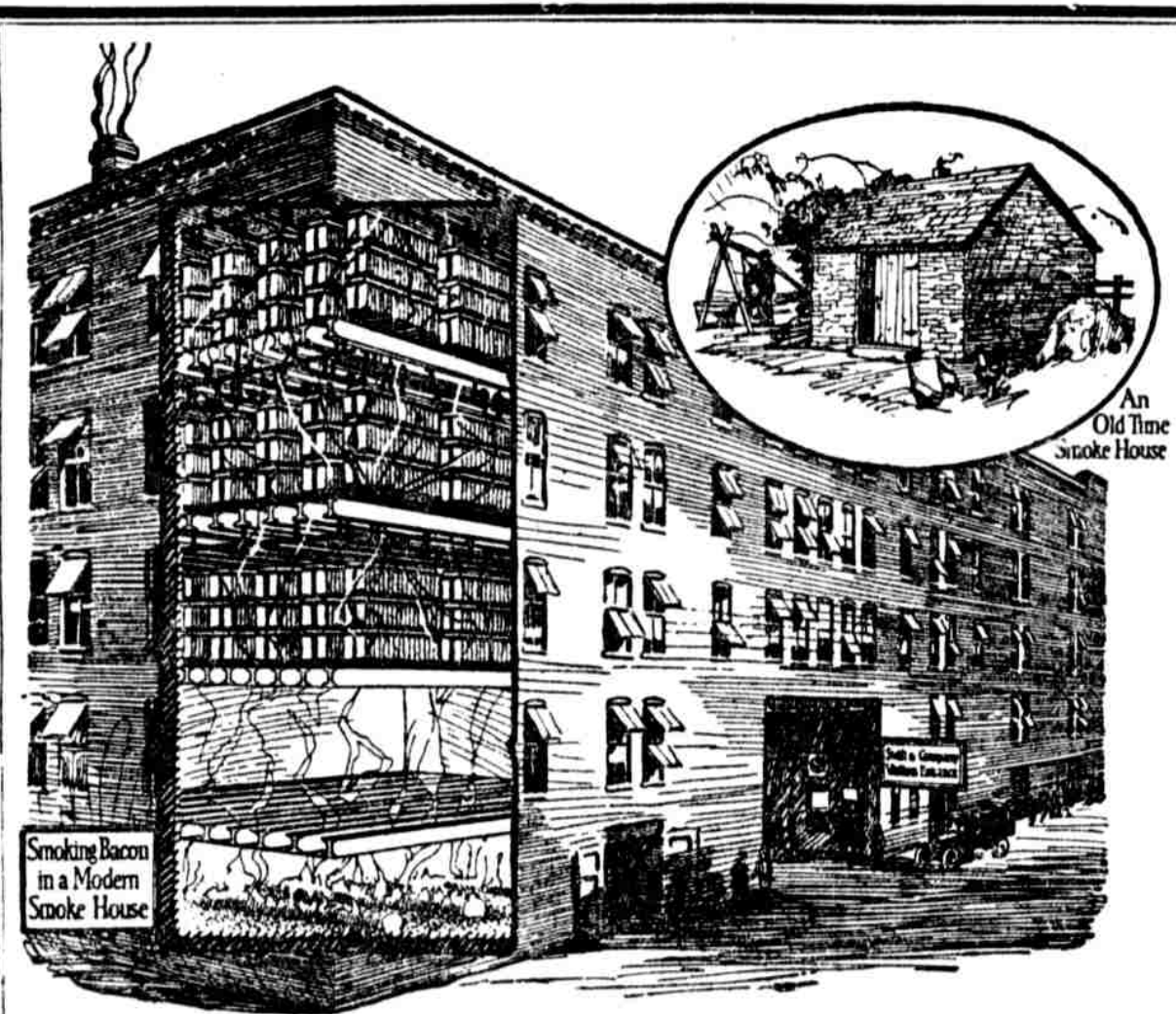
