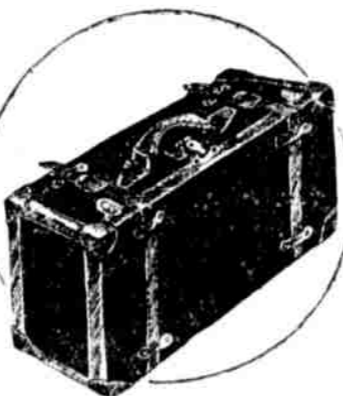

**Deep and Roomy Suitcases of Black Enameled Fabric—\$8**

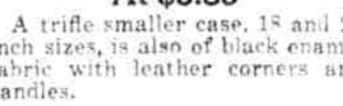


They're big enough to hold nearly everything one needs for quite a trip. Their capacity is really astonishing.
