

TIGHTEN RULES ON 'CHANGE

Amendments to Constitution Place Greater Restrictions on Members New York, Aug. 25.—A further tightening up of the rules of the New York Stock Exchange was accomplished yesterday by the adoption by its governing board of amendments to its constitution placing greater restrictions on activities of its members. The first one provides a severe penalty for any member who is in any way connected with or does business with a member of the exchange in bucket shop practices. The second refers to transactions between members and non-members in listed securities. 'Any member of the exchange,' the first amendment reads, 'who is interested in or associated in business with, or who is in any way connected directly or indirectly by private or public wire or other method or contrivance with, or who transacts any business directly or indirectly with or for any organization, firm or individual engaged in purchasing and selling securities for customers and making a practice of taking the side of the market opposite to customers in the transactions held for their account, shall, on conviction thereof, be deemed to have committed an act or acts detrimental to the interest and welfare of this exchange.' The other amendment provides that any member violating with a non-member in the rooms of the exchange a transaction in any security or property admitted to dealings in the exchange shall be subject to suspension for not more than a year.

Liverpool Cotton Liverpool, Aug. 25.—There was a good demand for spot cotton with prices firm on the basis of an advance of 3/8 cent for middling 9.0. Sales were 12,000 bales. There was no cotton in demand steadily in the early session. Spot prices were: American middling upland, 10.00; middling, 10.10; fair middling, 10.10; ordinary, 9.80; and ordinary, 7.00.
