Little New Financing in Sight

Phenomenal Gold Inflow

It is claimed that there will be no further disruption of the foreign exchange market as a result of the German reparations payment, which is estimated at 1,000,000,000 gold marks, and that the payment will still leave a substantial sum for the credit of Germany. That country has secured here a credit of approximately \$10,000,000 on silver which is still to arrive.
