

STREET CLEANING BY CITY PAYS WELL

Director Caven Declares \$350,000 Already Saved by Eliminating Contract Plan

COST TO DROP 15 PER CENT

Philadelphia has saved \$350,000 by cleaning the streets of the central section itself instead of giving contracts for the work, according to Director Caven, of the Department of Public Works.

He says the work by the city has been an unqualified success and expects the saving to pay the cost of equipment in the next two or three years.

Under the contractor system, the Director said, cleaning of streets cost the city approximately \$5,000,000. Under the new plan he looks for a reduction in cost of 15 per cent.

An incinerating plant in the Thirty-eighth Ward will be ready by the end of the year, a considerable appropriation of \$500,000 being available. Several other sites are being considered, but neighborhoods object to the plants and that has caused delay.

An appropriation of \$1,250,000 is available for equipment and stables. Director Caven said that only the best equipment would be purchased and that some of that would be procured from the present contractors. Fourteen hundred horses will be purchased and the work of inspecting such stock will begin soon.

Already bids have been asked for 275 wagons and 200 horses. A fleet of seventy-five wagons will be maintained as a reserve for the seasons when the collection of ashes and the cleaning of streets require the greatest attention.
