He also distributed newspapers containing accounts of police activities yesterday to throngs of jobless men.

### BURGENLAND CRISIS NEAR

Entente Ultimatum Threatening Blockade May Be Given Hungary  
Vienna, Sept. 20.—(By A. P.)—The situation in Burgenland, the strip of territory on the Hungarian border, is hourly growing more serious. It is reported that an Entente ultimatum to Hungary, to be delivered today, says a commercial blockade will be instituted unless the territory is completely evacuated by the Hungarians within seventy-two hours.
