KU KLUX OUTRAGES KEPT FROM PUBLIC

Former Resident of Florida Says News of Many Crimes Never Gets Out

AN EX-KLANSMAN TALKS

The masked tyrants and the outrages carried on under the cloak of the Ku Klux Klan and the menacing purposes of that secret order are confirmed vividly in letters received by the EVENING PUBLIC LEDGER since it began presenting an exposure of Ku Kluxism.

Among the many letters received is one from a Trenton man who formerly lived in Jacksonville, Fla. He writes:

During my stay in that city the notorious parade of the Ku Klux Klan took place through the streets, and about the same time occurred a series of startling outrages of which I had little, if anything, to know.

First, a business man of the city, apparently prosperous, and who from a somewhat later recollection, I believe was a Jew, was captured in an automobile taken to the country in an automobile garage and feathered, otherwise mistreated, then taken back to the city and dumped off at a one-story building on a residential street.

Example of Klan Ignorance In the third case I remember the victim bore a distinctly Irish name. He was also kidnapped, tarred and feathered and otherwise foully treated.

Similar outrages were employed in a case which occurred in the same period in a town outside Jacksonville. An attempt was made to kidnap a man who had refused to leave the place.

No One Tried for Murder Needless to say, no one was ever brought to trial in any of these cases, at least while I was in Jacksonville.

Plan Status of Simmons There is a plan to build a grand temple for the Ku Klux Klan in the city of Trenton, N. J., and the plan is being carried out by a committee of the Ku Klux Klan.

Many Facts Made Public The main facts that were made public regarding all the outrages so far mentioned by me were published in the Philadelphia papers of the time and, therefore, are easily to be verified.

But there are certain facts of outrages and other things mentioned in the territories which the Imperial Wizard never mentioned.

But no genuine sympathizer would care to discuss under his name anything that might be used to incite to violence.

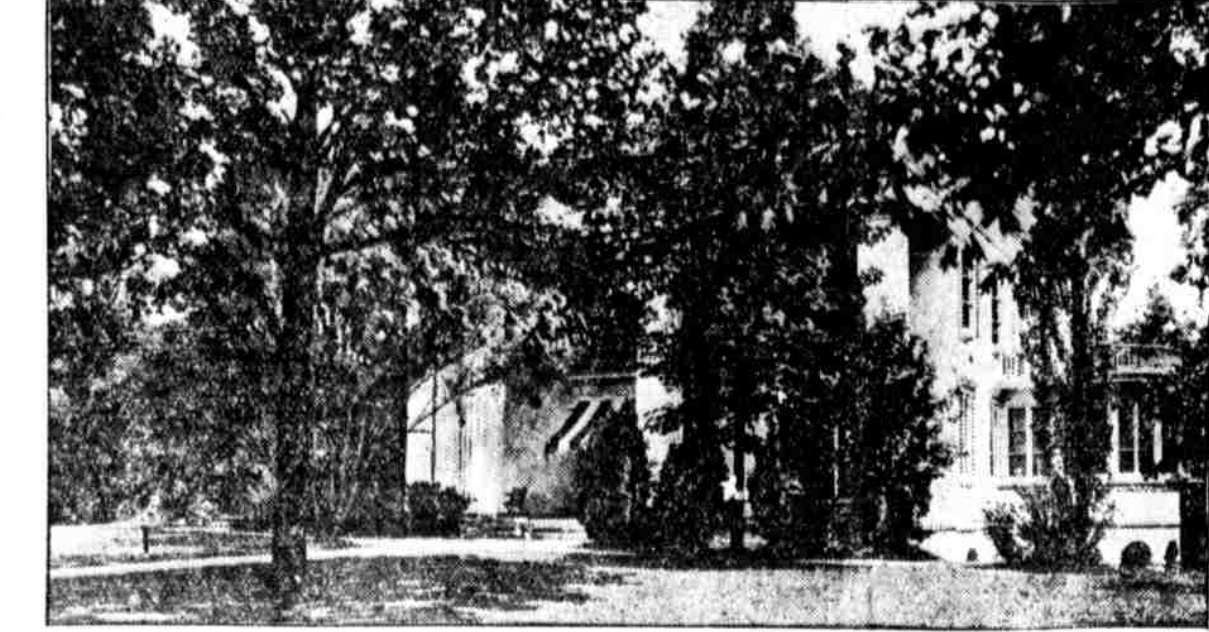
