Quince Preserves

Pare fifteen quinces and cut in quarters, then in thin slices. Cover with cold water and bring to a boil.

Quince Butter

Wash twelve quinces and cut in thin slices. Do not pare. Barely cover with cold water and cook until quinces are very soft.

Quince Jelly

Bring parings left from the quince chutney, the parings, cores and seeds with cold water. Bring to a boil and cook very slowly until soft.
