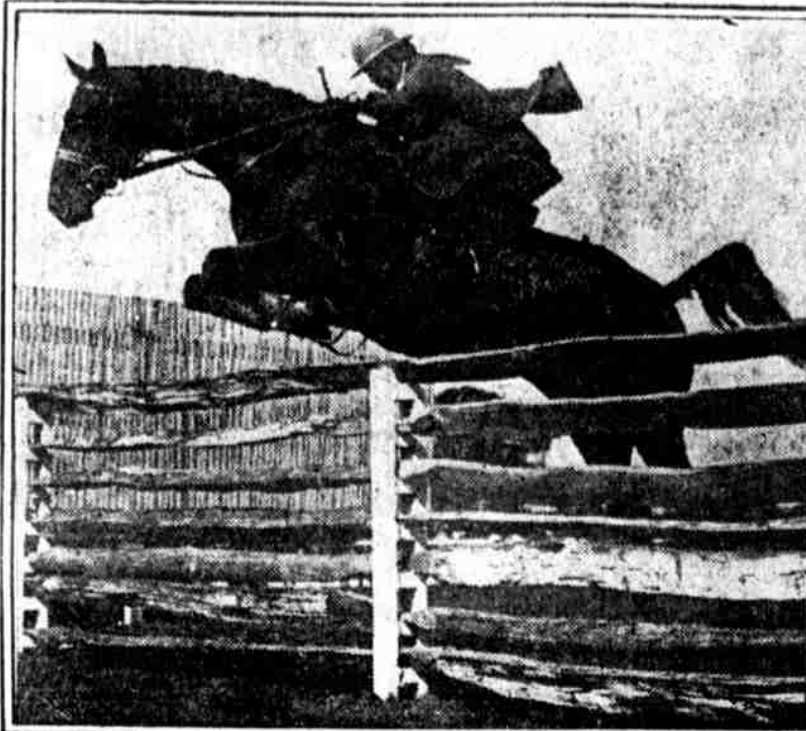

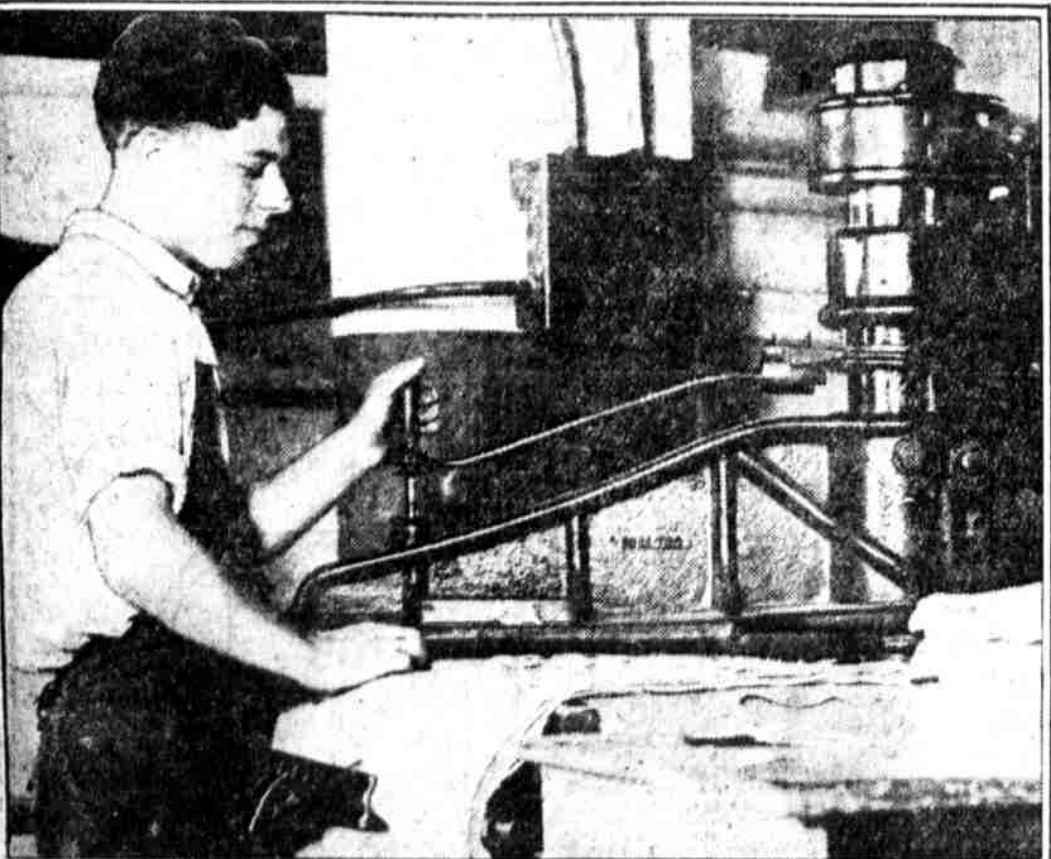

THEY ARE IN DANGER. The falling to sea of the Brooklyn fishermen, who were rescued by the U. S. cutter, Albatross, is being investigated.

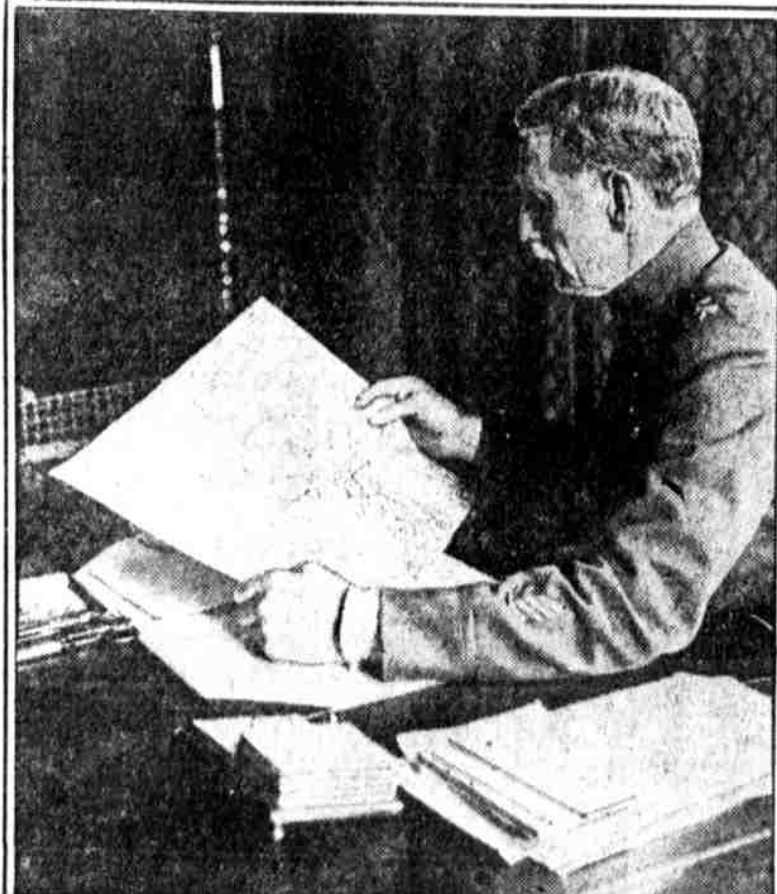
