More Jersey Frocks, \$10. One-piece frocks of fine Jersey trimmed with silk facings, are in brown, henna, navy and black. They have white or beige collars and cuffs of crepe de chine. (Sketched.) Other Jersey dresses, exceedingly popular with young women, are \$8.50 to \$18.75. New Silk Dresses Trimmed With Moire Ribbon at \$15. Unusual frocks of crepe de chine have up-and-down rows of narrow moire ribbon from neck to hem. These are in brown and navy and are in an excellent style for figures needing long lines. (Sketched.) Other pretty silk frocks, newly arrived, are trimmed with box-pleated panels from which hang little silk tassels, or with fluffy silk pompons. Others are trimmed with iridescent beads. All are simple and wearable and made of good silk crepes de chine and crepes metair.

Copies of Fine Gowns at \$35 to \$45. At first glance one would think that many of these dresses were straight from France, so closely have the French originals been reproduced. All are of fine materials—crepe-back satin, charmeuse, Canton crepe and Georgette—mostly in brown, navy blue and black. Not many of any one kind, which makes the selection all the more interesting.
