

ANNOUNCE NAMES OF 9 WAR MOTHERS

Philadelphia Members Will Attend Ceremonies at Arlington for Unknown Soldier Hero

LEAVE HERE FRIDAY

The names of nine of the war mothers who will attend the ceremonies attendant on the burial of the unknown soldier at Arlington Cemetery Friday were made public today.

These women will leave on a special train from West Philadelphia Station at 5 o'clock in the morning and will return late in the evening. They are: Mrs. Elizabeth Connelly, 726 South Twentieth street; Mrs. Caleb Jackson, 1208 Belmont avenue; Mrs. Florence Wille, 5510 Poplar street; Mrs. A. Berkowitz, 1730 Berks street; Mrs. Elizabeth Brule, 1206 North Conestoga street; Mrs. Margaret Bowers, 3549 North 11th street; Mrs. Margaret Curbin, 1820 South Twenty-fourth street; Mrs. Anna McNaney, 8515 Frankford avenue; and Mrs. Mary Stanton, 4043 North Broad street.

Mrs. Connelly has been selected to place the wreath of golden flowers and oak leaves on the grave of the soldier as the tribute of the war mothers of Philadelphia.

Such war mothers of the city as cannot attend the ceremonies at Washington will be entertained Friday evening by Mrs. William Roche and Mrs. Mary Branding.

There will be another ceremony here Saturday, when the war mothers will plant a tree in Logan Square in commemoration of the dead. These ceremonies will be in charge of Mrs. Blanche A. Bellak, and Mrs. K. F. Digner, head of the National Society of War Mothers, will speak. There will be a procession from the headquarters of the G. A. R. to the square.
