IT HAS BEEN supposed in certain quarters that last Tuesday was Good Citizen Day. But this impression seems to have been unfounded.

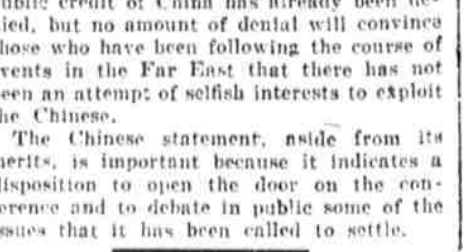
VALIDATING THE TREATIES

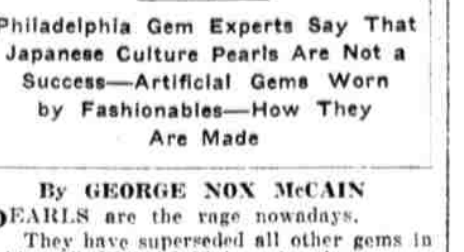
