## STEEL BOOKINGS DECLINE

Corporation's October Tonnage 273,  
481 Less Than Preceding Month

New York, Nov. 10.—The monthly tonnage report of the United States Steel Corporation made public today showed 2,734,841 tons of unfilled orders on hand October 31. This is a decline from unfilled orders on September 30, which were 2,805,870 tons.

The tonnage of 273,841 tons came as a surprise in view of the 28,744 tons increase in September, the first gain in more than a year.
