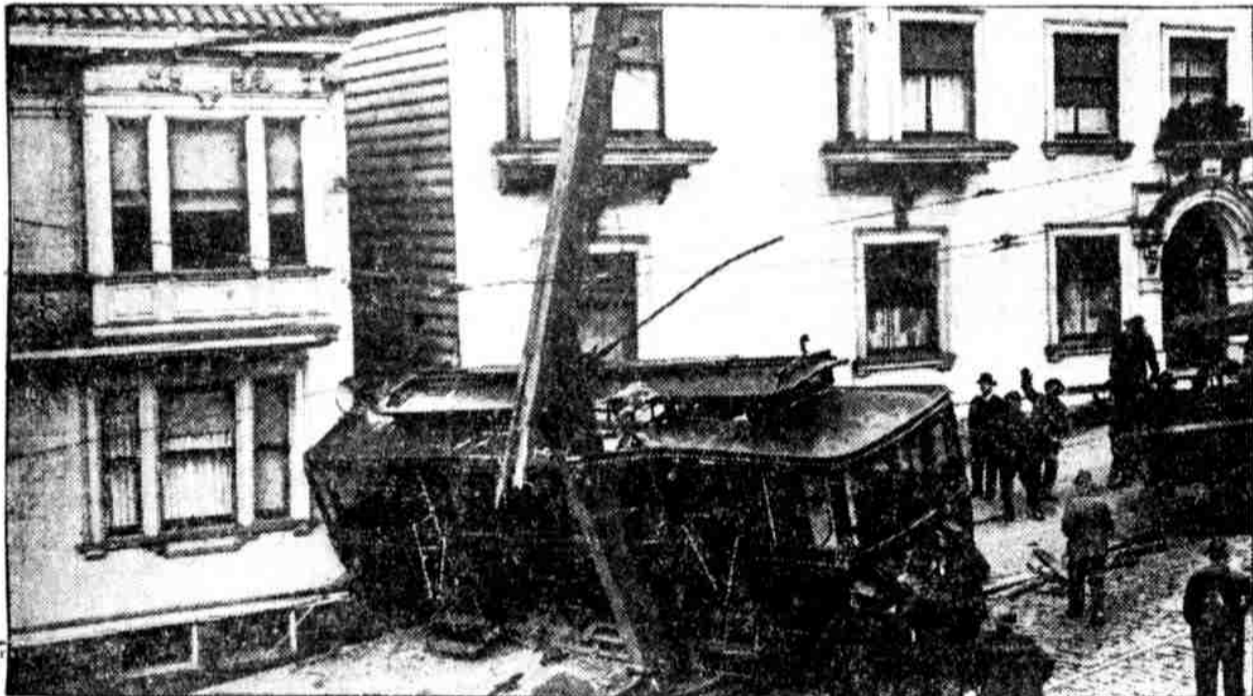
**GETTING READY.** Thomas Cripps brought the turkeys on South street for a Frankford friend.



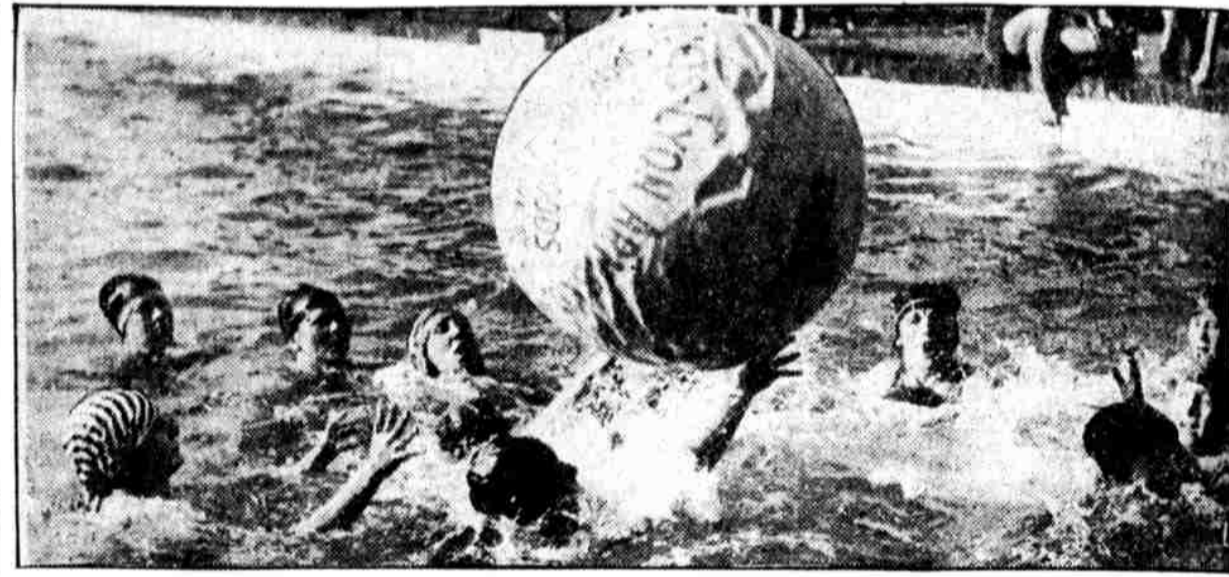

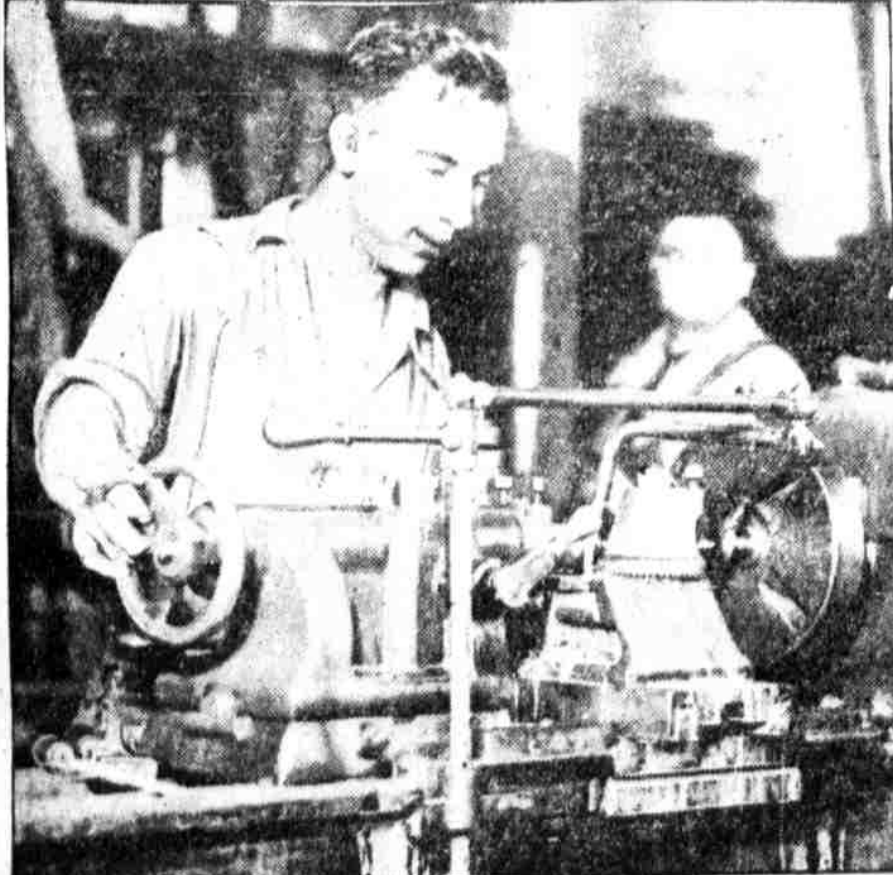
