

"It Is Imperial"

"Yestenday, induced a few mailing my letter to you. I went to the custom house, whence I took the plano and cauzed it to be transported without delay to Liszt's residence. Then I unpacked and installed it in the parlor of the maestro. Mr. Chickering was with me. As soon as the plano was on its legs the celebrated plantst scated himself before it, and the harp-like arpeggios, the bird-like trills, the thundering octave passages, which rolled from the noble instrument were most marvelois. About halfway in this tremendous test the maestro ceased playing and spoke thus (I give you his words verbatim): "C'est imperial? Je n'al jarmis cru qu'un plano pouvait posseder de telles qualities." (It is imperial? I never thought that a plano rouid possess such qualities.) Then, taking Chickering by both hands, with most hearty hand shakes, he said to him: "Cela yous fait honneur, monsieur!" Ce plano me donne envie de teacher du plano. Je yous in temeries, et J'en aurai un soln jaloux." (This instrument does you honor, sit. This plano makes me feel like playing the plano. I thank you for it, and will take most jealous care
