

MRS. WILSON'S WEEKLY MARKET BASKET HINTS

Shopping Personally for Eatables Gives Advantage of Picking Cheaper Ones

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The housewife who personally markets really obtains far better value for her money than she who either sends the children to the store or shops by phone.

For the Sunday menu this week I am going to plan using a new meat loaf with the glory of the winter vegetables, a salad and a new dessert for Sunday dinner.

A suggestion menu for three meals on Sunday:

BREAKFAST
Cereal and Cream
Potato Omelet Bacon Garnish
Toast Coffee

DINNER
Clear Tomato Soup
Spiced Meatloaf
Brown Gravy
Sweet Potatoes Braised Onions
Turnip Mole
Cold Salad
Butter Scotch Pudding Vanilla Sauce
Coffee

SUPPER
Welsh Rarebit on Toast
Creamed Potatoes
Cocoa
Chocolate Sponge Cake
Tea

The market basket will need Grapes, cereal, eggs, butter, bacon, one-half pound of Hamburg steak, one-half pound of fresh pork sausage, one-half pound salt pork, four onions, sweet corn, sweet potatoes, white potatoes, cabbage, turnips, onions, celery, can of tomatoes for tomato soup, brown sugar and usual weekly staples.

Potato Omelet
Parse three medium-sized potatoes and cut in thin slices, cover with boiling water and cook until tender, drain.

When they are nearly ready break four eggs in bowl and add

Now add the potatoes to fat left in skillet that bacon was cooked in and cook potatoes as for hashed brown.

When they are nearly ready break four eggs in bowl and add

One-half cup of evaporated milk.
One teaspoon of salt.
One-half teaspoon of pepper.
One teaspoon of grated onion.
Beat to mix. Now heat skillet smoking hot in which you have placed the four tablespoons bacon fat and pour in the egg mixture, as it sets, spread over the cooked potatoes. Add three tablespoons finely minced parsley, fold and roll and serve.

Spanish Meatloaf
Soak stale bread in cold water until it turns in piece chesecloth and squeeze very dry—rub through a sieve; now place in saucepan

One and one-half cups of milk.
Ten level tablespoons of flour.
Stir to dissolve flour, bring to a boil; cook slowly for five minutes; this sauce must be very stiff; turn from saucepan into mixing bowl and add

Three cups of the prepared state bread.
The Hamburg steak.
The fresh pork sausage.

The two onions, sliced, chopped fine.
One cup of finely chopped onion.
One cup of finely chopped green top celery.

One teaspoon of poultry seasoning.
One-half teaspoon of thyme.
One level tablespoon salt.
Mix and knead to blend thoroughly, then pack in large deep loaf-shaped pan, spreading the top smoothly, sprinkle with four tablespoons cornmeal, patting the meat gently into the loaf; bake one and one-half hours in slow oven and serve with brown gravy. This size loaf will serve two meals.

Brown Gravy
When loaf is nearly ready to serve on the country pork in very thin slices, cover with boiling water and then drain. Fry a delicate brown in skillet. Lift and lay on top of meatloaf, now add to fat left in the pan

One cup of onions, chopped fine.
One teaspoon thyme.
Two-thirds cup of flour.
Stir to blend and cook a deep mahogany brown. Then add

Three and one-half cups of cold water.
One tablespoon of salt.
One teaspoon of pepper.
Stir to blend and bring to a boil. Cook slowly for ten minutes; strain and it is ready to serve.

This amount will serve for two meals.
