

SERVES WARNING ON BRICK TRUST

Legal Activities to Bring New Inquiry, Lockwood Counsel Says

FAIL TO MEND THEIR WAYS

New York, Dec. 16.—The sting of prosecution for violation of State Anti-Trust Laws has not ended the alleged illegal activities of a combination of brick manufacturers along the Hudson River. It was charged before the Lockwood Legislative Committee yesterday by Samuel Untermyer, who exposed the organization of brick makers a year ago.

Mr. Untermyer also intimated he would seek to indict in State courts members of the tile combine, recently named in the Federal courts for Anti-Trust Law violations. Charging that the terra cotta makers, too, had not amended their ways as a result of prosecution, he announced that another fight would be waged against them.

Twice yesterday the committee conferred with twosome labor leaders in an effort to have certain unions in the building trades abandon practices through which witnesses charged them with unjust exactions made upon contractors increasing the burden on home owners.

Mr. Untermyer also attacked the plumbers' regulation forbidding the installation of bathroom, kitchen fixtures which come with faucets and other accessories attached.

Several brick makers along the Hudson were called to testify, but they were excused when they refused to waive immunity. Denton Fowler, of Haverstraw, N. Y., part owner of two plants there, admitted the brick

makers formed and still operated the New York Brick Company as a mutual sales agency and that one purpose was to seek price stability. The committee adjourned until January 6. In the meantime it will draft a tentative report to the Legislature of its investigation, which began fifteen months ago.

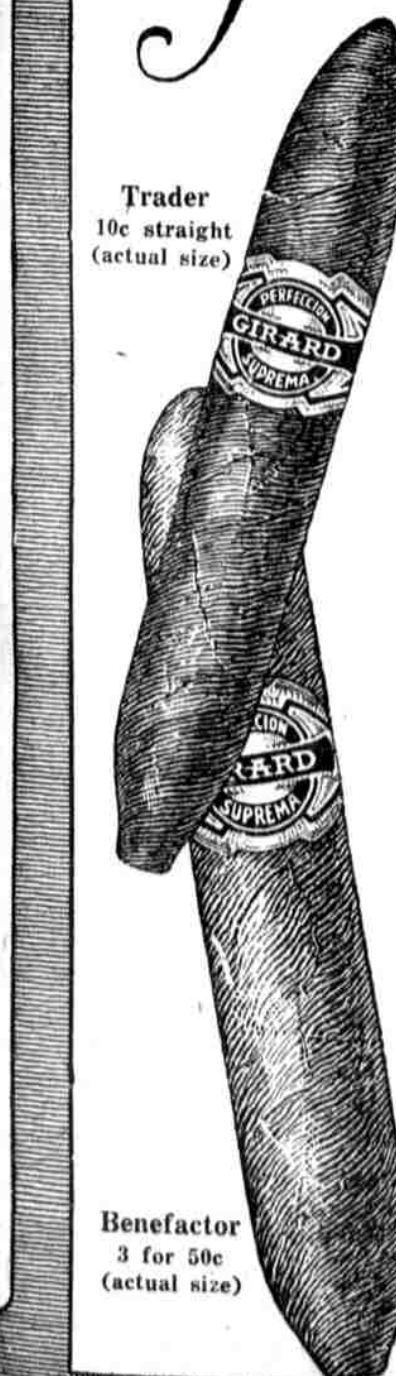

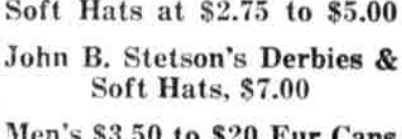
