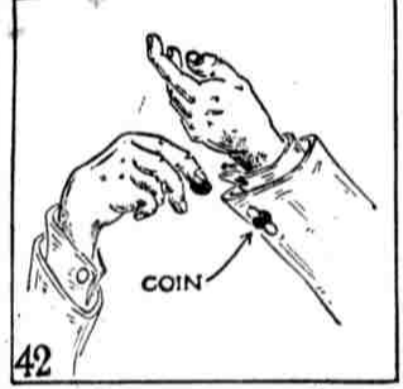


LAST-MINUTE SHOPPERS POUR INTO CITY BY CARLOADS
