

# CHILE AND PERU IN AGREEMENT

Delegates of Both Countries to Discuss Tacna-Arica Issue at Washington

BOLIVIA ALSO INVOLVED

By the Associated Press. Santiago, Chile, Dec. 27.—The Chilean Government has forwarded a note to the Peruvian Government accepting Peru's proposal that the two countries designate plenipotentiaries to meet at Washington to continue negotiations for a solution of pending disputes. The negotiations between Chile and Peru were begun a fortnight ago. Their chief aim is a settlement of the Tacna-Arica controversy.

The latest Peruvian note is considered upon favorably by the Chilean press. El Mercurio and La Nación. They agree that it is a development bringing the negotiations to a more realistic stage. La Nación thinks a meeting of plenipotentiaries in a foreign capital will be a satisfactory method of determining just what is to be arbitrated.

Lima, Peru, Dec. 27.—By A. P. The Peruvian Government on Sunday sent a note to Bolivia saying that Peru would take special satisfaction in cooperating with Bolivia to bring about arbitration of the disputes between Bolivia and Chile, provided the present controversy between Peru and Chile could be settled by arbitration.

The Peruvian note is in reply to a communication from Bolivia in which the Bolivian Government raised the point that the Tacna-Arica question was not the only problem resulting from the war of 1878. "In consequence," the note says, "the present negotiations have fostered constant international discord."

The Bolivian note suggested that in case Peru and Chile were unable to arrive at an agreement regarding the sovereignty of the disputed provinces of Tacna and Arica an international conference composed of interested and friendly nations be called to solve the whole South Pacific problem.

### SHORE TRUCKMEN PROTEST

Say Lone Dealer Collects All Fees for Weighing Vehicles

Atlantic City, Dec. 27.—Hundreds of owners of trucks here are protesting a ruling from William L. Dill, Motor Commissioner, under which one dealer here has been designated an "official weighmaster" and to whom all truckmen must go to receive official weight slips before obtaining licenses to operate in the State. They say they are assessed fifty cents for the weighing, and are curious to learn where authority for the fee is vested. Shore motor officials say it is permitted under the laws and means "authorities" granted the State Motor Commissioner. Opponents of the rule say they will seek a court ruling.
