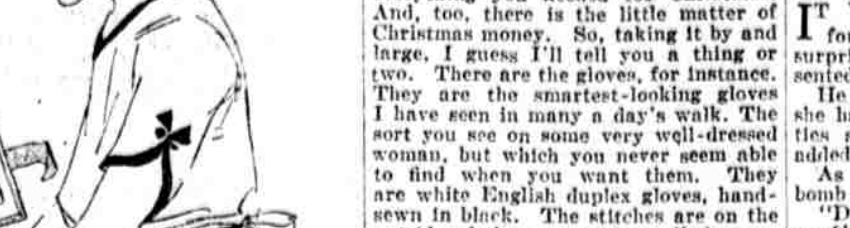

It is rather deplorable that though the girls aren't big enough to come to their senses alone, but the fact remains that they do want to be popular with men and they will do the things that will make them popular.

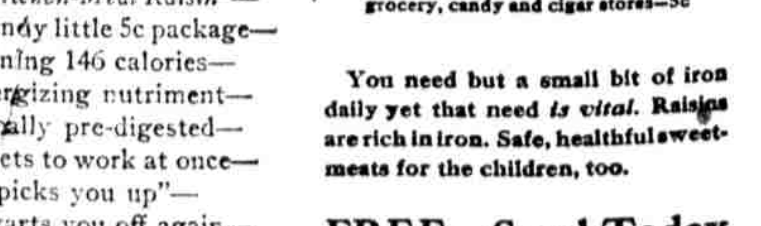
