George Pearl, Haberdasher, Is Robbed on Fifteenth Street Near Pine

MRS. P. F. ROTHERMEL, 33—Highwaymen took \$1535 from George Pearl last night as he was passing a darkened section in the rear of the School of Industrial Art, Fifteenth street, near Pine street. Two checks in a wallet they removed from his coat pocket were returned.

Pearl, who is a haberdasher and lives at Fifteenth and South streets, was walking south on Fifteenth street when two men jumped out of the shadow of the building. They both held pistols at Pearl's head. He made no resistance.

One hand kept his pistol at Pearl's head while the other examined his wallet. He showed the money in his pocket and replacing the checks in the wallet, said: "Here, take those checks. You may be able to use them. Now beat it through De Lancey street before we shoot you."
