"I wish my tree had legs instead of roots," he cried. "This way I could run and travel about the earth."

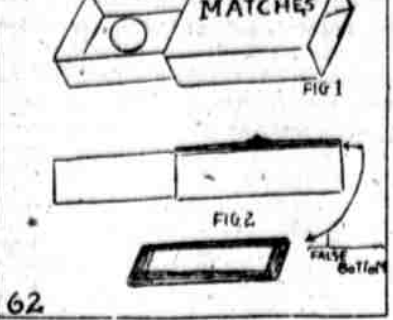
