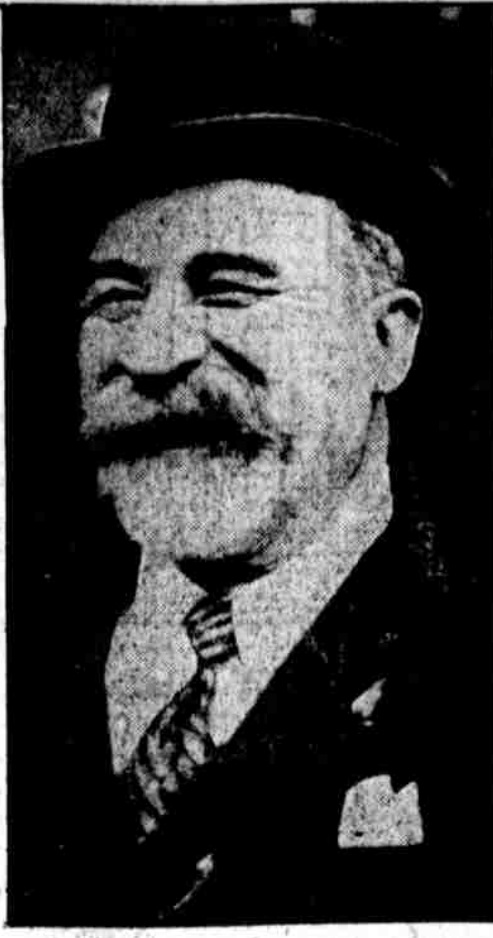




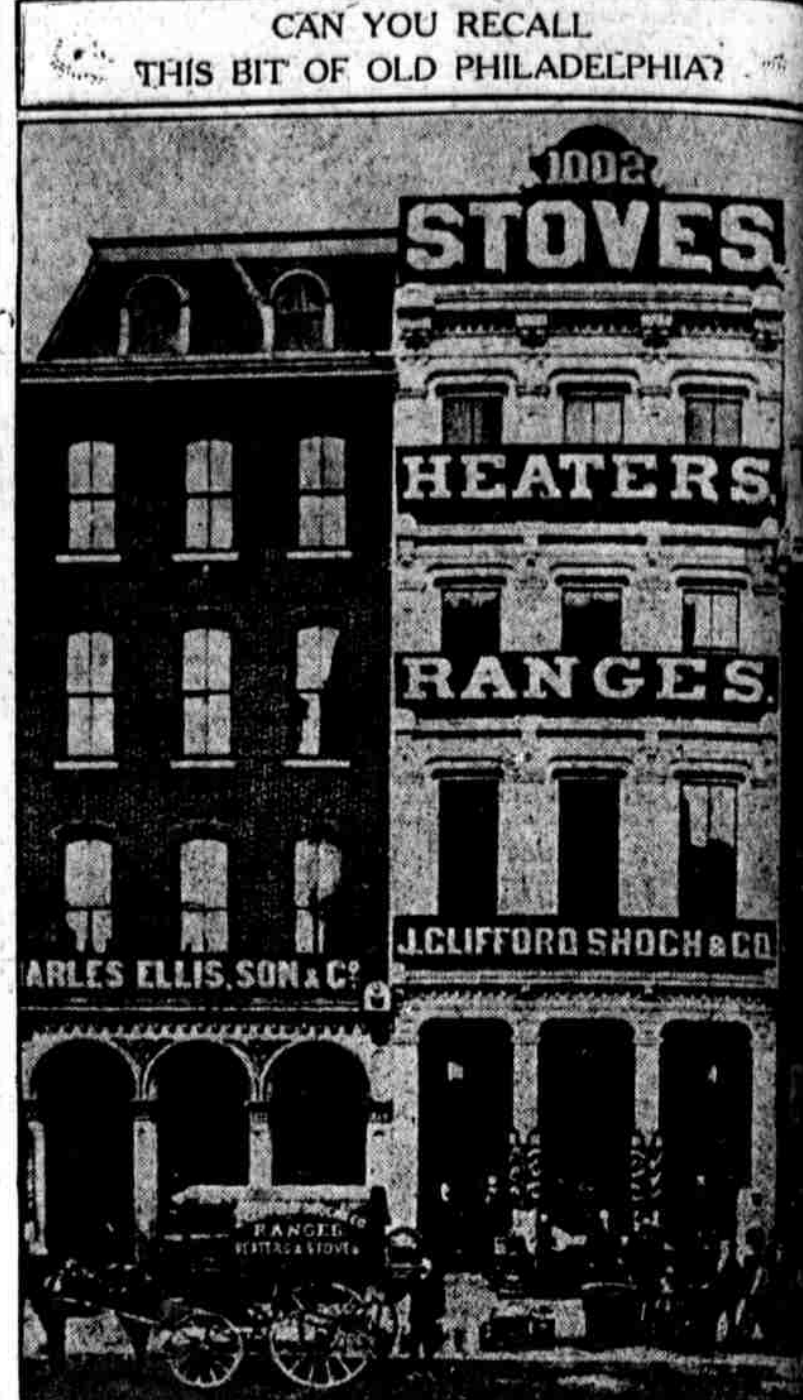

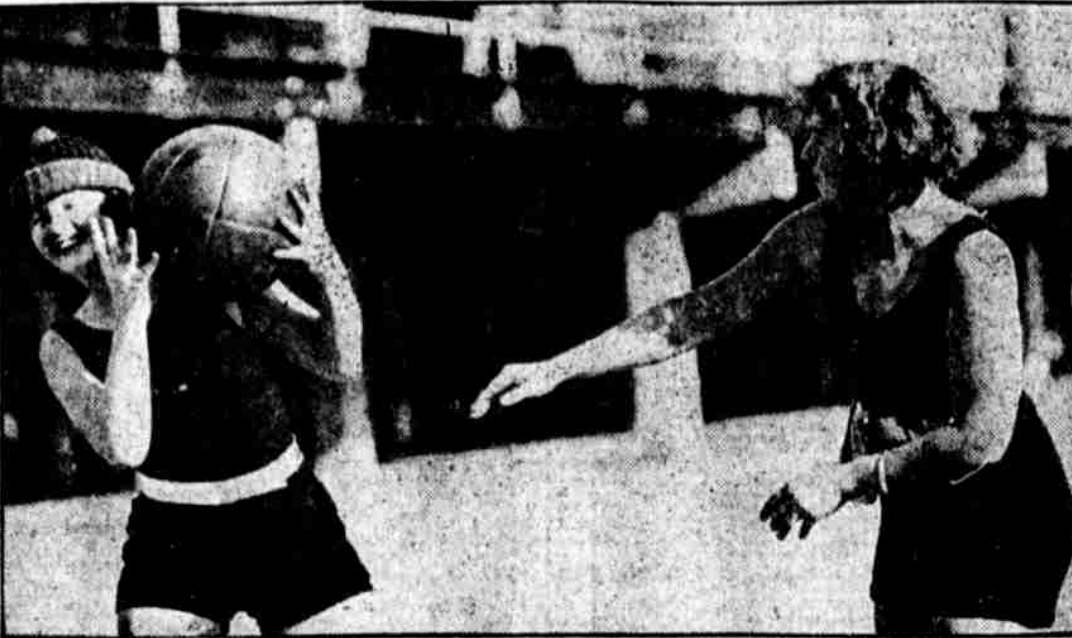
DR. THOMAS E. FINEGAN head of the public schools of Pennsylvania, snapped in Harrisburg.

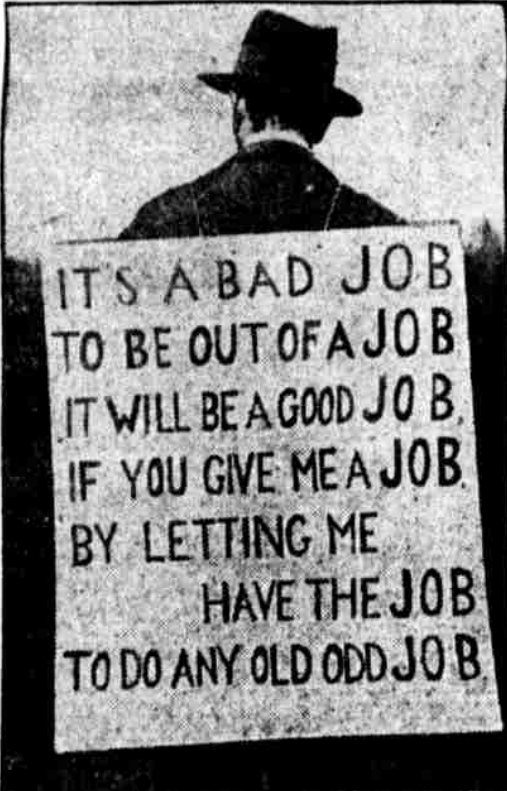
WILLIAM S. CULBERTSON has been made vice chairman of the United States Tariff Commission.

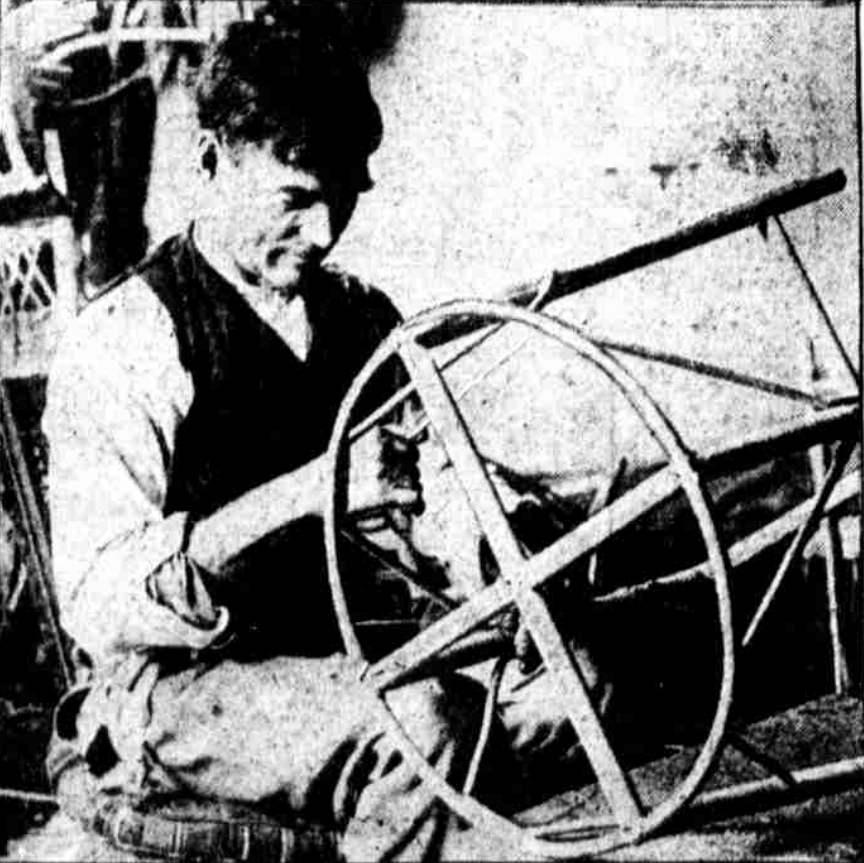
