

### 6 ORPHAN CHILDREN END FRIGID MARCH

Leave Frozen Bodies of Parents  
and Tramp Many Miles  
Through Snow

### BOY OF 14 LEADS THEM

Fort William, Ont., Jan. 27.—Six little Indian children, who left the frozen bodies of their father and mother in the northern trapping wilderness, today reached Waterloo on the Canadian Government Railway after a fortnight of tramping over snow-covered ground. The five younger children, ranging upward from a baby of a few months, were brought back by their fourteen-year-old brother and a neighbor.  
Their father, Atchimio Nan Tuchoes, trapper, and their mother both died of influenza in the family's woodland hut on Friday, January 15. That day the father called Atchimio, the oldest boy, to his bedside, told him the end was near, gave him \$1200, the fruits of his trapping, and bade him care for his brothers and sisters. There was little food in the home.  
Unable to bury the bodies, Atchimio left them in the shack with the five other children while he set out on snowshoes to fetch the nearest neighbor, thirty miles away. Two days later Atchimio came back with John Hingooosh, the neighbor. The five younger children were chewing raw moose deer for nourishment. They had burned most of the furniture to keep from freezing. The bodies of their parents were frozen stiff.

Washington, Jan. 27.—(By A. P.)—Charles W. ### PHILA. FIRM GETS WARSHIPS

Eight of Nine Obsolete Craft Awarded to J. G. Hitner & Sons  
Washington, Jan. 27.—Eight of the nine obsolete warships recently offered for sale by the Navy Department have been awarded to the firm of J. G. Hitner & Sons, of Philadelphia, the Navy Department announced today. The aggregate bid by the Hitner company, which was the highest received, was \$235,000 for the eight ships.  
The ninth ship, the old cruiser Memphis, now wrecked on the shores of Santo Domingo, was recently sold to A. H. Radetsky Iron and Metal Company, Denver. The ship will be broken up for scrap, it was said.
