

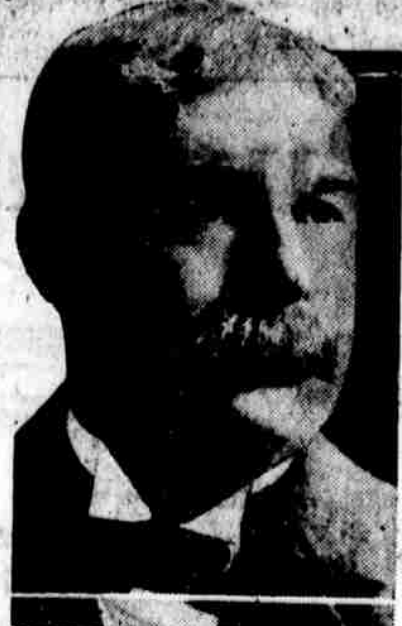
PEPPER EXPLAINS STAND ON BONUS

PRUSSIANISM IN ARMY, MAJOR SAYS

Favoritism and Inefficiency Rule, Alleges Officer, Himself Under Charges

Washington, Feb. 6.—Major Malcolm Wheeler-Nicholson, of the Third United States Cavalry, who risked court-martial for insubordination in going over the heads of his superiors to send a letter direct to President Harding, alleging 'that Prussianism, favoritism and inefficiency ruled in the treatment of junior officers in the army,' said last night he had made the charges regardless of consequences to himself for the good of the service.
