### 14 RAIL MEN GET PENSIONS

Reading Puts Faithful Veteran Employees on Honor List

Fourteen employees of the Philadelphia and Reading Railway were added to the company's pension list during the last month. This is the largest number of men added to the pension list during any one month since April, 1921.

Three of the men served the company for more than half a century. They are William P. McCoy, toolkeeper, five years, seven months of service, pensioned January 1, 1922; James P. Simon, engine inspector, engine house, Rutherford, Pa., fifty-three years, six months of service, pensioned January 1, 1922; and Joseph S. Kohl, section foreman, Norristown, Pa., fifty-one years, seven months of service, pensioned November 1, 1921.

During last month eight on the pension list died. Two of these men were in the company's employ for more than half a century. They were Robert R. Haine, auditor freight traffic, Philadelphia, fifty years, nine months of service, pensioned August 10, 1919, and John Delagr, engineer, St. Clair, Pa., fifty years, six months of service.

### DEADLINE FOR SHOPLIFTERS

Known Members of Fraternity Are Barred From Central District  
A deadline against known shoplifters has been drawn around the city's central shopping district. Shoplifters trespassing within the bounds of the line are liable to arrest on sight. The plan, which has been used against safe-breakers and burglars in the financial district of other cities, was announced yesterday as the result of a conference between Director Cortelyou and J. L. Ravennell, secretary of the Stores' Mutual Protective Association.

The area in which members of the shoplifting fraternity, whose photographs are in the Rogues' Gallery, are liable to be arrested on suspicion is from Sixth street to City Hall Square and between Market and Walnut streets. Police are co-operating with the protective association to curb the activities of the shoplifters and special attention is to be paid to thieves from other cities who make a flying visit to Philadelphia. The raids are made most frequently on "mile days."

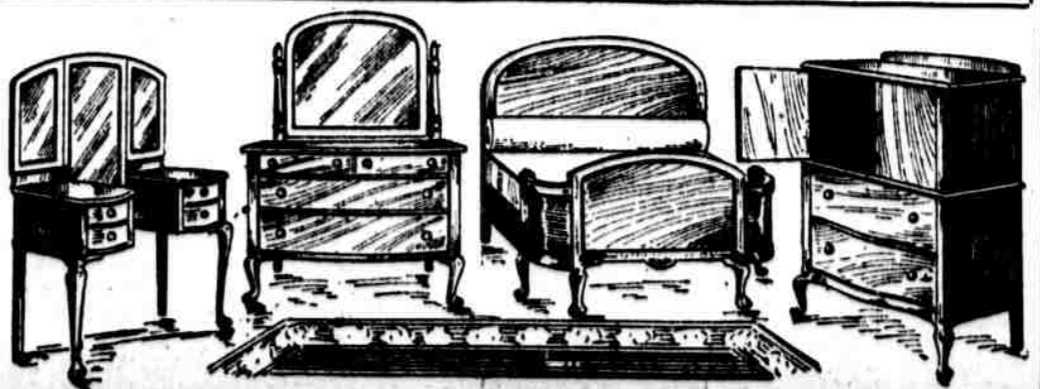
