Oser, who is still absent from Zurich, has accepted the conditions under which the McCormick family gave their consent to the match, which were that he take up his residence in the United States and become a citizen of that country.

IOWA SENATOR SWORN IN

Millerand Refuses to Halt Execution, Set for This Week Paris, Feb. 24.—(By A. P.)—President Millerand has refused to commute the sentence of Henri Landru, the "Bluebeard" of Cambrai, as he has been petitioned by Landru's counsel. It was announced this afternoon.

LEWIS HARCOURT, BRITISH STATESMAN, IS DEAD

Former Colonial Secretary Married Daughter of New Yorker London, Feb. 24.—(By A. P.)—Viscount Harcourt died here last night, aged fifty-nine years.

Lewis Harcourt was born February 1, 1863, the son of Sir William George Granville Venables-Vernon-Harcourt, English statesman.



He served at various times as Privy Counsellor and First Commissioner of Works, and from November, 1910, to May, 1915, was Secretary of State for Colonies. In 1905 he was created Baron Nuneham, and was made a Viscount in 1917.

His wife, whom he married in 1889, was Mary Edith Burns, only daughter of the late Walter H. Burns, of New York and North Myram Park, Hatfield, England.

From 1904 until he was raised to the peerage he was a member of Parliament for the Rosendale division of Lancashire, and was known as a strong opponent of women's suffrage. He was offered the post of Secretary of State for Ireland in July, 1910, but declined it.
