**WABBED, VANISHES**

Former Philadelphia Stock Salesman Arrested at Shore After 3-Year Search

**HAS BAIL-JUMPING RECORD**

Atlantic City, March 3.—Released under \$5000 bail awaiting the arrest of extradition papers from any of a half-dozen cities to answer various charges, William L. Girwood, former Philadelphia stock salesman, is believed to have again jumped his bond.

Girwood was arrested here last week on a telegraphic warrant from Philadelphia charging false pretense. He was arrested at one of the leading Boarding houses, where he was stopping with his wife and twenty-year-old son, Captain of Detectives Joseph Ferretti sought to have the man held without bail. No precedent could be found for such procedure and he was released under cash bail of \$5000 by Benjamin Fitzgerald, a local politician.

Girwood was required to report daily to the police, but has not been seen since Tuesday. Magistrate Joseph A. Fasson intends to confer with Judge Legeron today with regard to forfeiting the bail and the bond-man will be advised to produce Girwood or default.

Girwood, who is said to have many aliases, is much wanted. According to the police his operations have netted him thousands of dollars. He faces a dozen warrants alleging conspiracy to defraud, forgery and larceny. The shore police have received advices from Philadelphia, Glenolden, Lancaster and Chicago to hold him.

The police say Girwood first identified himself with an influential brokerage office and won the confidence of its clients. He then left their employ and from his list of customers got deposits on stocks and bonds, doing the disappearing act with a rich haul before being discovered.

According to the shore authorities, records show that Girwood twice jumped his bond in Philadelphia. He has successfully eluded arrest nearly three years, information received here shows.

**Mrs. Frady Dies, Shot by Husband**

Miami, March 3.—Mrs. Edgar C. Frady, of Chicago, sister of John H. Thompson, Chicago restaurant owner, who was shot here Sunday by her husband, who later attempted suicide, died yesterday.

Frady, who came here recently to recuperate from a nervous breakdown, attempted suicide after the shooting by slitting his throat. Physicians say he will recover.

**WAVES SMASH LIFEBOATS**

Steamship on Way to Aid Freighter Sinking Off Cape Race

Boston, March 3.—(By A. P.)—Radio stations along the North Atlantic seaboard today were actively seeking news from the Norwegian freighter Gronof, Galveston for Eshjers, which was reported sinking yesterday with twenty men aboard, five hundred miles southeast of Cape Race.

The latest word from the Gronof said all her lifeboats had been smashed by the stormy seas. The steamer Antonia was reported on her way to the sinking steamer, and mariners here believe it arrived in time to save officers and crew.

**2 SCOWS FULL OF WHISKY**

Police Seize Thousands of Bottles of Once-Popular Brand

New York, March 3.—(By A. P.)—Two scows full of bottled whisky of a brand popular in pre-Prohibition days were seized today in Westchester Creek off 17th street and seven men composing the crews were arrested. Inspector Lieders believes the liquor was smuggled from Cuba.

Three patrol wagons, working in relay, transported the several thousand bottles in burlap bags to a police station. Trucks lumbering down to the wharf at an early hour and an unusual number of lights on the scow led to the seizure.
